Module 1: Overview: This module introduces students to the cloud architecture and system requirements for Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations. The servicing and support model and Lifecycle Services integration are also covered in this module.

Module 2: Deployment and Servicing: This module dives into the details of deploying hotfixes and updates and refreshing test environments.

Module 3: Email and Printing: This module will help you understand how to configure email and printing options.

Module 4: Data Management: This module introduces students to data entities. You will gain experience configuring and troubleshooting data imports in the Data Management workspace, deploying aggregate measurements to the Entity Store, and working with data in Excel.

Module 5: Manage Security: In this module you will learn how to add users, configure security roles, and troubleshoot access issues. You will also learn how to move security configurations between environments.

Module 6: Monitoring and Diagnostics: This module teaches you how to use the monitoring and diagnostics tools available in Lifecycle Services to troubleshoot issues and tune your environment.

Module 7: Troubleshooting Tools: When Lifecycle Services monitoring and diagnostics information isn't available or doesn't address your issue, it is important to understand what other tools are available to you. This module covers some additional tools such as the Performance Timer and Trace Parser.

Module 8: Batch Processing: In this module you will learn about the batch framework, how to configure and schedule batch jobs, distribute your batch processing load, and send alerts when jobs fail.
