Full configuration support end dates

Support for Office 365 ProPlus is defined by the [Modern Lifecycle Policy](#), which requires customers to maintain an up-to-date configuration in order to stay in support. Support for non-subscription versions of Office is defined by the [Fixed Lifecycle Policy](#), which offers a fixed term of support regardless of configuration. However, the nature and extent of support available for in-support, non-subscription versions of Office running on out-of-support versions of Windows will depend on the nature of the specific issue. How to use these tables (example): I am running Office 2016 on Windows Server 2016. How long will my full configuration be supported by Microsoft? From the header row in the left-hand table, I find that Office 2016 will reach end of support (EOS) in October 2025. From the leftmost column in that table, I find that Windows Server 2016 will reach end of support in January 2027. Where that row and column intersect, I find that my Office 2016 client applications will continue to be supported on Windows Server 2016 until October 2025, when Office 2016 goes out of support. From the right-hand table, however, I can see that if I am using Office 2016 with any Office 365 services, I will no longer be considered in support after October 2023.
