

# 5 Signs Your Technicians Are Hoarding Inventory

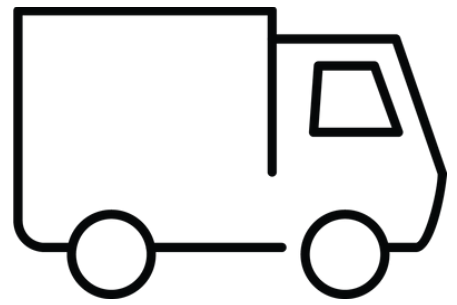


## 1) INVENTORY IS DISAPPEARING.

If your technicians are not sure what is at the bottom of the pile of parts and supplies in their trucks, they probably have a lot more product than they really need and are wasting fuel from the weight.

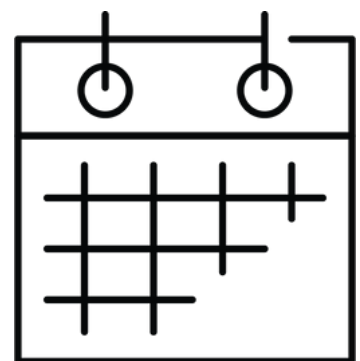


## 3) YOUR TECHNICIANS ARE STORING INVENTORY IN THEIR GARAGES.
