What is PowerLine?

Microsoft Azure is wonderful, powerful, massive, and **complex**.

PowerLine **simplifies delivery** of Azure's power to customers. PowerLine itself is a PaaS service delivered as SaaS services. You need PowerLine to focus users on their problem and not on the cloud development. What really makes PowerLine truly revolutionary is its companion client services. Available under subscription licenses and fully integrated with PowerLine and Office 365 users get a no-code, ready to run Windows 10 UWP application. PowerLine provides through automation all the normal and necessary services for your applications. Add the integration to Office 365 and you have a complete solution for most any business problem.

What is it used for?

PowerLine and its companion Windows 10 apps: ReAccess, ReWeb, ReBase, and ReSQL **upgrade your existing application assets to Azure cloud apps**. It is designed to replace everyday internal business process applications in government and business. Built from the ground up with government in mind, PowerLine has all the ingredients normally requested in government project requirement (audit, logging, security, etc.)

Use it to upgrade existing Microsoft Access, desktop apps, FoxPro, and just about anything with a user interface. Built so non-technical people can use it. It also unlocks your data by using Azure Cosmos DB as the data store.

How does it work?

PowerLine is like a condominium apartment, ready to move into. PowerLine is connected to all the Azure service resources for you to input and operate on business data. With a simple Office 365 Excel spreadsheet you configure one of the client apps of your choice with very simple commands. No programming skills are required, you just need to know your business. PowerLine compiles your commands into the app and it is ready to run. Takes about two seconds.
