Civil engineering consultancy boosts earnings with TidyWork project management



A UK civil and structural engineering consultancy, Crouch Waterfall, based south of London and Bristol, has not only increased its billable

Lee Kemp, Business Co-ordinator, explained that the consultancy handles maintenance of bridges and other structures on the railways, rivers and canals all over Britain, a lot of the work being carried out at night.

"We used to have handwritten timesheets and pulled all that information into Excel files for each job" he said. "Not only did that introduce massive room for error, but there were lots of double entries and duplicated information. It would not be until the end of the project that we really knew whether we were working at a loss or keeping to budget".

Crouch Waterfall now does its accounting in the cloud using Xero and it was the consultancy's

accountants who recommended TidyWork because it integrates so well with Xero and enables invoicing to be carried out directly from actual workflow and time records.

Gillian Walker emphasises the importance of TidyWork records being able to estimate more accurately the costs of potential projects.
