ODT Rentals 365, Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central and, optionally, Office 365 give users access to a full suite of accounting capability, rental management, and office productivity tools including Excel, Word, and Outlook in one system. Move up from QuickBooks with a conversion utility and ditch the spreadsheets and standalone rental systems.



Rental Functionality

The system will track unlimited rental units, including current rental status, and offers flexible rental terms with user-definable periods. Rental terms can be for blocks of hours, day, week, month, or a custom period length. Rental unit groups allow companies to track rental demand without committing specific units until ready to ship. A copy utility allows for easy setup of new units when acquired. Available rental documents include rental quotes, order confirmations, and invoices. Customers can be billed for optional damage waivers.

Users can start with either rental quotes or rental contracts. Pricing options include optimization or proration. Invoicing can be done at the beginning or end of rental periods for both rental and sale transactions. Users can choose to track availability or allow for overbooking when alternate sources of rental equipment are available.
