Why Journal Control?


Generally, in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central, the role of journal line is to temporarily hold the transaction data until it is ready for posting. Since, it is in draft any one can modify it, once it is posted it is converted to ledger entries.

Often these journal lines create a havoc due to wrong or false information input by the user and the organization has difficulty to clear things out. Journal Control, a simple yet powerful app is the extension of your existing system which helps the organization to set a boundary on who creates and who posts.


This app also helps the user to create – modify – delete the journal entry. This is specially designed to work only with your accounting journal.

 Journal Control designs can easily activate or de-activate based on the user requirement. As it is set-up-based functionality.




- Create, modify and delete the general entries.
