General Settings

1 - Base Currency

This should be set to the base currency you wish to use. All other currencies you have setup in your Dynamics instnace will be expressed as a decimal multiplier of this currency. It is recommended that you set this to be the same as your system base currency.

2 - Data Source

Schedule Settings

3 - Frequency

This is the frequency with which you would like to synchronise foreign exchange rates.

Name	Description	Notes
Monthly	Rates are synchronised monthly on the day specified by the 'Day' setting	Valid 'Day' values are 1-31 but recommended values are 1-28 (see notes against 'Day' setting for more info.)
Weekly	Rates are synchroised once a week on the weekday specified by the 'Day'setting	Valid 'Day' values are 1-7 (1 = Mon, 2 = Tues etc.)
Daily	Rates are synchroised once a day	The 'Day' setting is ignored

4 - Day

This value is used differently depending on the 'Frequency' value choosen.

Name	Description	Notes
Monthly	The day of the month that the rates should be synchronised.	Valid values are 1-31 but recommended values are 1-28. If 29, 30 or 31 are used the rates sync will only take place in months that that have that many days. For example, if you choose 29, the rates will not be synced AT ALL in February (unless it happens to be a leap year). If you were to choose 31, rates would not be synced in April, June, September or November
Weekly	The day of the week that the rates should be synchroised.	1 = Monday, 2 = Tuesday, 3 = Wednesday, 4 = Thursday, 5 = Friday, 6 = Saturday, 7 = Sunday

5 - Time

The time of day, expressed as a decimal, at which the synchronisation should be performed. Times should be specified in UTC. The minimum value is = 0.00 (Midnight), the maximum value is 23.59 (1 minute to midnight.)

Conclusion

That's it, all done. Save your config. Within a few minutes the next Run Date will have been scheduled. You can double check that you have correctly configured your desired schedule by opening your configuration again and checking the Next Run Date:
