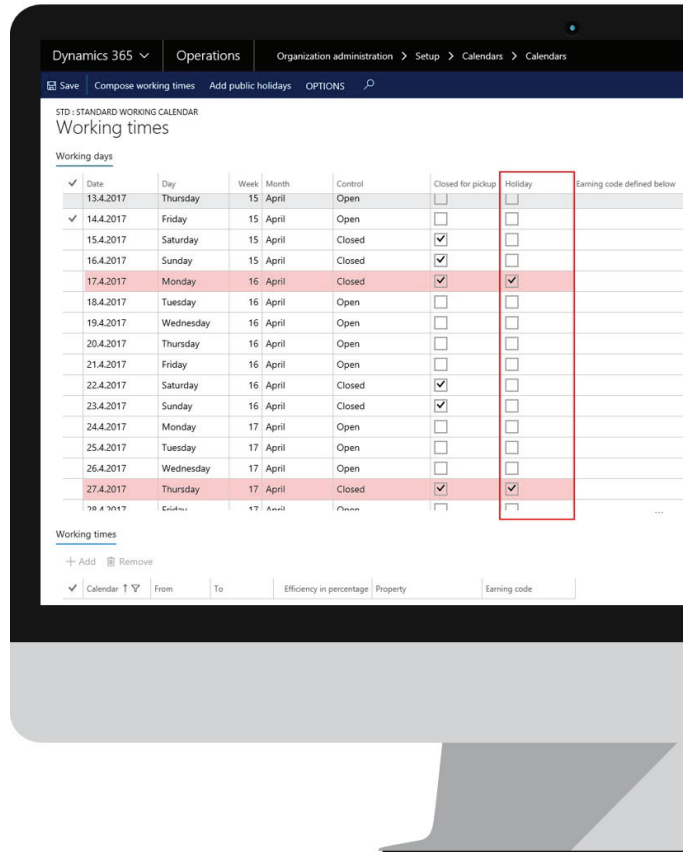

Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations - Enhanced Calendar functionality with public holidays



Standard calendar functionalities in Dynamics 365 are enhanced with an additional option - the ability **to create public holiday calendars with different methods** of entering public holidays and their calculation rules.

- + Different calculation methods: **fixed and calculated dates**
- + The ability to generate and use **multiple public holidays calendars**
- + Can be **added to standard calendars automatically**

Different calculation methods for holidays

1. Fixed Method


3. Easter
