# **Overview**

DXC Smart Business Form Email Manager for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Finance and Operations is a simple and smart solution for automated emailing of business forms and other reports to your customers and vendors. The solution automates distribution of business forms and reports based on contact preferences using rich format email templates. The following are example business forms processes that can be streamlined using the DXC Smart Business Form Email Manager solution:

- Customer
  - Sales quotation
  - Sales order confirmation
  - Sales delivery note
  - Sales invoice
  - Free text invoice
  - Project invoice
  - Customer account statement
- Vendor
  - Purchase order
  - Payment Advice

#### **Email Distribution**

Business forms are sent automatically using email templates and are directed to recipients based on contact information setup on the customer account.

- Email distribution may be controlled with the ability to hold and release documents before they are sent with the capability to fix and resend emails with incorrect addresses.
- Email content is authored using placeholder tags which dynamically looks information up from the business form or report to include in the email subject or body.
- Email can include the business form as well as additional file attachments associated with the business form or report.

# Save to Azure Storage

DXC Smart Business Form Email Manager can also save copies of the emailed/printed business forms or reports into Azure storage. This allows for an archive of the actual business forms produced and sent. File location and file name can utilize placeholder tags which dynamically looks information up from the business form or report to include in the file name and define the Azure Storage location. Any fixed list placeholder tags are stored as metadata against the file in the Azure Storage.

#### **Extendable**

While out of the box functionality is for the business forms listed above, the solution can be extended on further business forms or reports, and technical guide is provided or alternatively upon request can be evaluated for product enhancements.

DXC Smart Business Form Email Manager for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Finance and Operations is simple to deploy, setup, and configure. Using the Microsoft Dynamics 365 extension framework you can deploy continuous updates for your Microsoft Dynamics 365 installation while maintaining compatibility with the add-on without taking a new release or merging code<sup>1</sup>.

# **Features**

# Automatic routing to multiple email addresses:

Run processes such as invoicing or EFT payments once and automatically send business forms, reports and attached documents to appropriate parties using configured email addresses. Supported reports for automated routing:

- Customer
  - Sales quotation
  - Sales order confirmation
  - Sales delivery note
  - Sales invoice
  - Free text invoice
  - Project invoice
  - Customer account statement
- Vendor
  - Purchase order
  - Payment Advice
- Extendable to other business forms and reports for automated routing using included extension points

Email addresses are configured on customer and vendor contact information as well as customer and vendor contacts. Recipients can be assigned for single or multiple business forms and reports based on user definable address contact information purposes.

# **Email Templates**

- · Embed document details directly in the body of the email for professional and contextual emails
- · Create unique email templates for each process or report
- Send any report using a rich format email template

# **Email management**

- · Emails can be held before sending
- · Email send errors can be fixed and re-sent.
- Customer/Vendor accounts missing email addresses can be printed or routed to an alternative email account.
- Attach other recipients dynamically including the current system user as a To: Cc: or Bcc: recipient.



### **Re-Send Business Forms**

- Ability to resend reports to individual recipients directly from the user interface. Supported forms:
  - Sales confirmation journal
  - Free text invoice
  - Sales invoice journal
  - Sales packing slip journal
  - Sales quotation journal
  - Project invoice journal
  - Project invoice list
  - Purchase order journal
  - Vendor payment history
  - Payment journal

Automatically attach additional documents saved with the business form source record

# **Auto Archive to Azure Storage**


- Auto archive reports to Azure blob storage with configurable and dynamic file names, directory locations

# **Other Features**


- Quick setup using data entity for uploading contact information. May also be used for continuous updates.


Screenshot 1. Email templates including fixed and dynamic placeholder tokens




Screenshot 2. Email template body including fixed and dynamic placeholder tokens


Screenshot 3. Email parameters defining the business form, email template, recipients, and Azure storage settings




Screenshot 4. Customer/Vendor Contact information record.




#### Screenshot 5. Assign 'Purpose,' to contact information on account or account contact person
