The WSB Tech Trade Essentials extension provides a collection of features and improved and new functionalities that will benefit many Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central customers active in the trade sector. These functionalities are developed for companies active in the wholesale of technical goods, but not limited to those companies, as the functionalities will benefit many other customers who wholesale goods.


The extension is a collection of multiple features and will continually be improved and extended with new functionalities. Currently the extension comprises the following:

- ✓ Orig. Unit Price and Line Discount %
- ✓ Manual price
- ✓ Price Signaling
- √ Item Price Import/Export
- ✓ Close old price records


Installation

The WSB Tech Trade Essentials extension can be installed from Extension Management page of the Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central.

If WSB Tech Trade Essentials extension is not listed in the available extensions, then open Extension Marketplace page from Extension Management page and choose WSB Tech Trade Essentials in the AppSource.




When WSB Tech Trade Essentials extension is selected and the Extension Installation page is opened, click Next:




After installation the users must re-login to have WSB Tech Trade Essentials extension activated:





Permissions Configuration

Once WSB Tech Trade Essentials extension has been installed, the permission set TECH TRADE ESSENTIALS has been added to the system.



This permission set should be assigned to relevant users or user groups.

To assign the TECH TRADE ESSENTIALS permission set to users:

- 1. Choose the Lightbulb icon on the top right corner of the Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central to open search, enter **Users**, and then choose the related link.
- Select the user that you want to assign permission to. Any permission sets that are already assigned to the user are displayed in the **Permission Sets** FactBox.
- Choose the Edit action to open the User Card page.
- On the User Permission Sets FastTab, on a new line, fill in the Permission Set field with TECH TRADE ESSENTIALS
