Login to the management system

To login to the Content Management System (CMS), go to **URL** http://domain.nmlabs.gr/admin/ where the input page is displayed and fill in the credentials you have been given.

! This is a temporary URL!

As soon as the e-Shop is completed and live, the URL will be of the form https://domain.xx/admin/




Image 1 – Administrator's login page

Username:

In this field, fill in the username provided by the system administrator.

Password

Fill in the password provided by the system administrator. If you forgot the password, please contact the administrator.



Manage pages

To view the content / pages of the website select from the top menu Content > Pages.



Image 2 - Pages tree-like table

On your screen you will see the list (hierarchically) with the site's content pages. If a page has subpages, then an arrow pointing to the right () appears on the left of the page before the title. Clicking on the arrow displays the subpages of the corresponding section (*).





Image 3 - Subpages

From this section you can add and delete pages as well as retrieve information.

More details:

- Modified At: Displays the last modified date.
- **Exclude Sitemap:** If the icon is ² then this page is excluded from the Sitemap, if it is ³ then the page is included in the Sitemap. You can click on the icon to change the status of the page directly.
- **Published:** If the icon is then this page is published and is displayed in the e-Shop, if it is then the page is not published and is not displayed in e-Shop. You can click on the icon to change the status of the page directly.

Actions section:



-> Edit Page

i -> Delete page



The number displayed next to each page's title (e.g. Terms of Use [283]) is the unique identifier of the page (ID).

Add a new page

To add a new page, click on the button at the top right of the screen. The page will be added at the end of the list.

To add a page under another, select the icon from the Actions section on the main page.

A page consists of the following fields:




Image 6 - Page Fields

Contents tab



- **TITLE**: the title of the page
- TITLE_MENU: the title of the page displayed in the e-Shop menu (e.g. main menu, menu footer)
- **TEXT:** the main text of the page
- **SEO**: data used by search engines e.g. Google
- **SUMMARY:** short description
- EXTRA_TEXT_1: additional text

NOTE: Texts should be added in all available languages.

Optional Fields tab:

Optional fields which, depending on the content of the page, contain additional information.

Attributes tab:

Optional features that may be completed depending on the implementation.

Documents Tab:

- IMAGES: you can add or remove images with drag & drop in the marked box.
- **DOCS:** you can add or remove documents (WORD, PDF) with **drag & drop** in the marked box.

NOTE: Files should be less than 1MB

Settings:

- Created at: the date that the page was created
- Modified at: the date that the page was modified
- **Published:** the option to publish the page or not in the e-Shop
- **Template name**: this field is filled in with the name of a predefined template when a particular presentation of the information on the page is required

NOTE: Template Name is not essential. To find the correct template name for a new page, check the corresponding field of <u>a similar and identical layer on the page tree</u> that you want to add.

- **Flags**: special flags to format the page if required according to the artwork.
- Forward To: you indicate the link to be redirected when this page is selected by entering the url after the language, as the first part of the URL is automatically taken. For example, from http://domain.nmlabs.gr/en/female-300 just mention the piece after the "el /": female-300 or directly the page id 300.
- Exclude From Sitemap: excluding the page from the Sitemap

WARNING: If you are not sure which fields to fill in, open a <u>similar page and the same level in the tree</u>, see which fields are filled in and fill in the corresponding page on the new page.



Edit Page

To modify the content of a page, select "Edit" () in the Actions section.



Image 7 - Page editing

To save the changes, press the button Save the changes, press the button to cancel the action and close the window.

Delete page

You can delete a page by selecting the delete button in the **Actions** section.



Image 8 - Delete a page

Some pages are not allowed to be deleted because they are essential for the proper operation of the e-Shop, for example the **Home Page**.

When you click delete, a new window opens. If you agree to delete, you will choose otherwise choose Cancel.




Image 9 - Delete page



NOTE: Suggested management is not to delete the pages but to report them as unpublished to prevent data loss.

Add file to page

- To view the files displayed on a page, select the **Documents** tab on the page.
- To add a new image, drag & drop the image in the dotted box below the Images field. Correspondingly, you add documents under the **Docs** field.
- **To edit a file**, select the image editing button (\square), as shown in the following picture.




Image 10 - Image editing button

After selecting the button, the edit window appears.




Image 11 - Image editing window



- Title: you give a title to the image
- Path: indicates the location of the image
 - o preview the image
 - the management system's file manager opens
- Link: you can provide a link for redirection
- New Window: the link will open in a new tab

To save your changes to the image, press the "OK" button and then the "Save" button in the page editing window.

To save your changes on the image, click the "Save" button below the image, then click the "Save" button in the page editing window. Otherwise, press the "Cancel" button to cancel the action and close the image editing window.

NOTE: Each image should have a <u>unique name</u>, regardless of the page that is added.

Delete file

You can delete a file by selecting the bin icon on the top right of the file frame.




Image 12 - Delete image

NOTE: If you want to upload a new file but with the <u>same name</u>, first delete the file and save the page. Then reopen the page and add the new file.

Add image in the TEXT field

You can add additional images inside the text of the page from the **TEXT** field.






Image 13 - Picture inside the text

In the window that appears, in the first "Image Info" tab, you select the "Browse Server" button and in the new list you select "images". Then, drag n 'drop the image from your computer to the folder and select it.

IMAGE DIMENSIONS: maximum length 790 pixels, suggested height 280 pixels.




Image 14 - Select image from File manager

The width / height fields in the **Image Info** tab will be filled automatically, but you will need to clear the values. On the **Advanced** tab, fill in the **"img-responsive"** value in the **Stylesheet Classes** field.






Image 1 - Responsive image

Add video in the TEXT field

You can add a video in the description field (**TEXT**). The video should first be uploaded to an application like **YouTube**. Then copy the **embed code** found in **Share > Embed**:

In the **TEXT** field, select the **Source** button.





Image 16 - Source selection

Place the cursor where you want to add the video, for example in the next line after the end of the text and paste the code from YouTube.

Then you have to add the following items that are in **bold**: (not in bold is copy-paste from YouTube):

Finally, select "Save" to save the changes.

Home Page

The home page consists of the following sections:

- 1. Carousel (See section Add Image to Carousel)
- 2. NEW ARRIVALS 4 new products (See Products section)
- 3. Top Categories (See section Contents Boxes: HOME_FEATURED_PAGES)
- 4. SPECIAL OFFERS 16 suggested products (See Products section)
- 5. SHOP BY BRAND (See section Contents Boxes: HOME_BRANDS)
- 6. Banner (See section Widgets: Home Bottom Banner)

Add image to Carousel

To see the contents of the home page's carousel, select the arrow on the left of the "Homepage [239]".



Image 17 - Carousel Pages



Each subpage that appears below the Homepage, as shown in the picture, is a Carousel slide. Carousel can display up to 5 slides. If you want to add a new slide, follow the procedure described in "Add a New Page" and then follow these steps:

To change the image in Carousel:

- 1. Select "Edit" in the "Actions" section of the slide page you want to modify.
- From the Documents tab, drag & drop the image in the box below the Images field. The new image will appear in the preview list to the right of the box. The dimensions of the image must be 1170 x 540 pixels.




Image 18 - Images tab

- 3. In the **Forward To** field, fill in the ID of the page you want the image to redirect to.
- 4. You can fill in the **TEXT** field with a short text that will appear above the image along with the title. In this case, if the **Forward To** field is also filled in, a button will appear to make the redirect.
- 5. Select the **Published** field if you want the slide to appear on the site.
- 6. Click the **"Save"** button to save your changes. Otherwise, press the **"Cancel"** button to cancel the action and close the window.

NOTE 1: Each slide always displays an image, regardless of how many are registered. This will always be the first one in the preview list.

NOTE 2: To display the new slide you added, you need to register it in the appropriate content box. (See Contents Boxes: CAROUSEL HOME).

Add shared image

On the **Homepage [239]** you can add a photo that will be used by the social media as default when the page you are sharing does not have a photo. The suggested dimensions are **1200** x **630** pixels.



Contact page

The contact page consists of the contact form as well as the information for the user to contact you. In the **TEXT** field of the <u>Contact page</u> [291], fill in the contact information. To update the pin on the map you should input the coordinates in the fields:

Optional Fields Tab:

String Field1: latitudeString Field2: longitude

Contents Boxes

Content boxes are specific areas on the website where you can declare their content, pages or categories. To view the available content boxes, navigate from the main menu in the section **Content > Contents Boxes**.

Some content boxes display titles, for example, in the footer columns corresponding to "FOOTER_MENU_COL_1-2-3". These titles can be changed from the **TITLE** field of the corresponding content box.





Image 21 - Add title to content box




Image 23 - Content Box: CAROUSEL_HOME





Image 26 - Content Box: FOOTER_MENU_COL2

HOME_BRANDS \rightarrow This box contains the TOP BRANDS that appear on the home page. Brands are categories and are selected from **Items** > **Categories**.




Image 28 - Content Box: HOME_BRANDS

Widget / Banners

To view the banners appearing on the e-shop pages, navigate from the main menu in the section **Content > Widgets**.




Image 29 - Selecting Widgets Menu



In detail, the banners present in the e-Shop are:

Cart aside: The banner that appears on the side of the shopping cart. Dimensions: 210 x 63 pixels




Image 30 - Cart aside banner

Categories aside banner 1: It is the banner that appears next to the product categories of the e-Shop. Dimensions: **240 x 300 pixels**




Image 31 - Categories aside banner 1

Category bottom left banner: The banner that appears at the end of the e-Shop product categories on the left. Dimensions: **588 x 210 pixels**

Category bottom right banner: The banner that appears at the end of the e-Shop product categories on the right. Dimensions: **588 x 210 pixels**




Image 33 - Category bottom right banner




Image 37- Page aside banner

Product bottom banner: It appears at the end of the product pages. Dimensions: 1170 x 180 pixels




Image 38 - Product bottom banner



Add new banner

To add a new banner, follow these steps:

- 1. From the main menu select the section **Content > Widgets**.
- 2. Press the button at the top right of the screen.




Image 39 – Add new widget window

- 3. On the screen that appears, select "Image" type.
- 4. Type a name in the Name field (eg "aside banner xx") and click Add.
- 5. On the new screen, type in the **Container** field the name of the container you want your banner to contain (eg "PAGE_ASIDE"). Available Containers are displayed in the list of widgets in the Container column.




Image 40 - New Widget Fill in Window

- 6. Upload the desired image in the **Images** field with drag n 'drop.
- 7. In the Publish field, select to publish it.



8. Select Save to save or Cancel to return to the menu without saving.

Edit banner

To edit the contents or properties of a banner, select the edit button ($^{\square}$) to the left of the name to open the editing page shown in the image.




Image 41- Widget edit screen

- 1. **To delete the image**, click on the icon of the image.
- 2. **To add an image**, drag & drop the image in the box below the **Images** field. To the right of the box, you see a preview of the image you've added to that banner.
- 3. **To add a link to the image**, select the edit button () and add the URL in the Link field. If you want Link to open in a new window from the "**New Window**" field, select "Yes".
- 4. **To change the order of appearance** in relation to the other banners belonging to the same container, move the **Gravity** field bar. The lower the price, the higher the priority.

After making the modifications you want, select the button to save your changes. **Otherwise**, press the button to cancel the action and close the window.

Delete banner

To delete a banner, edit the banner you want to delete to open the banner page. Click on the top right of the screen.

Add Multilingual banner

Multilingual banners are banners that change according to the language chosen by the user. For the appearance of a Multilingual banner, firstly three separate images have to be created which will be of the same format (eg .jpg). Names must be the same with the suffix:

- _el for the banner (image) displayed in the Greek language
- _en for the banner (image) displayed in the English language
- and an image with the same name but without the language extension

For example, it will be of the form image_name_el.jpg, image_name_en.jpg and image_name.jpg.

Photos must be uploaded to the File Manager, so you create a new page from **Content> Pages** and upload the two images with the language extension (eg image_name_el.jpg, image_name_en.jpg) from the **Documents> Images.**

Then go to **Content> Widgets** and edit the banner you want to be multilingual. In the **Images** field, you upload the image that has no language extension (image_name.jpg) and select the **Multilingual** field.

Finally, click **Save** to save the changes.

Verbals

Throughout the website there are individual words or phrases that can be edited from **Content> Verbals**.

Examples of verbals that appear are:




Image 44- Examples of Verbals

To edit the text contained in a verbal, click on the edit button () on the left of the **Key** field.

After making the modifications you want, press the button to save your changes.

Otherwise, press the button to cancel the action and close the window.



WARNING: Do not change the contents of the "Key" field.

Basic text formatting commands

: new line

text: Displays the text in bold

Attributes

Attributes are the characteristics of products and categories. To see the available attributes, navigate from the main menu in the section **Content> Attributes.**




Image 46 - Selecting Attributes Menu

When clicking a button, the Attributes window appears, and clicking on the title of an Attributes Type displays its entries.

Add attribute type

Attribute types are groups of characteristics, for example Color, Size. Adding a new attribute type can be done by the Add button on the left column as shown in the figure below.






Image 47 - Add Attribute type

The information to be filled in is:




Image 48 - Attribute type edit window

Contents:

• **TITLE** – The title of the attribute type that will be displayed in the e-Shop in all languages.

Settings:

Name – Attribute name of the attribute type in Latin characters.

- **Presentation:** you indicate how many values a product can get in that attribute type:
 - O None: no value, will not be displayed at all
 - o Single: only one value
 - o Multiple: multiple values
 - Single var: has a single value
- **Required:** You choose if it should be mandatory to complete it.
- **Published:** You choose to be published and used in the e-Shop.

NOTE: You must at least fill in the title filed of the attribute type



Add new attribute

Attributes are the values of Attribute types. To add a new Attribute, first select the Attribute Type to which you want to add a new attribute and press the button above the Attributes table.




Image 49 - Add an attribute to Attribute type "Size"

The fields you need to fill are:




Image 50 - Attribute Fields

Contents:

• TITLE: The title of the attribute that will be displayed in e-Shop in all languages.

Settings:

• **Published:** You choose for the attribute to be published and used in e-Shop.

Then press the button Save to save your changes, otherwise press the button action and close the window.



Edit attribute

By clicking **Edit** in the title of an Attribute Type or Attribute you have already created, you can edit it by opening the corresponding edit window.

Delete attribute

To delete an attribute, select the checkbox on the left of the attribute, and then select the delete button as shown in the image below.




Image 51 - Delete Attribute

WARNING: If you delete an Attribute Type, all attributes belonging to it are deleted. If you do not want a group of attributes to appear on the website, instead of deleting it, it is recommended that the field **Published** is changed to "No".



Categories

To view the categories, select **E-Shop> Categories**.




Image 52 - Categories

To edit an existing category, select the edit button and open the window as shown in the image below:




Image 53 - Category Edit

To add a new category you select on the top right, it will appear at the end of the list.

To add a subcategory, select the add button () in the category you want to add.




Image 55 - Add subcategory

The information that must be filled in is:

Contents tab:

- TITLE: category name
- TITLE_MENU: the category name as will be displayed in the menu
- TEXT: a brief text that will be displayed on the page of the corresponding category
- SEO: information used by the search engines eg. Google

Attributes tab: Fill in the attribute values that the products should have to appear in that category

Example 1: In the **Women** category we want all women's products to appear, so in the "Gender" attribute we select the "Women" value. In this way, the category will display all products that have the "Women" value in the "Gender" attribute.

Example 2: In **Men> Shoes** we want men's shoes to appear, so in the attributes we fill the "Men" attribute in the "Gender" attribute and in the "Category" attribute the "Shoes" value.

Documents Tab:

Images – category image, dimensions: 574 x 280 pixels

Settings:

Published – select for the category to be published



Brands categories

Product brands (manufacturers) are declared as categories from **E-shop > Categories** under the **BRANDS** main category. The information to be filled in is:

Contents tab:

- TITLE manufacturer name
- **TEXT** short text

Attributes tab: select the corresponding name in the attribute type "Manufacturer"

Documents tab:

• Images: manufacturer image, dimensions 100 x 100 pixels

Settings:

Published: select to publish the category

Filters in the product list

To define the filters in the product list, from the E-shop> Categories section select the Settings button.

In the window that appears, in the "Filters" field are declares the attributes that will be used as filters in the list of items displayed in the e-shop when a category is selected.




Image 57 - Listing attributes as filters

The order that are added is also the order that will be displayed in e-Shop. Depending on the category selected, only the corresponding attributes of products belonging to that category appear as filters. To change



the order displayed, select the attribute you want to move with drag & drop and leave it in the desired position.

Products

Products are added in e-Shop from E-shop> Products.

To add a new product, click the button on the top right of the page.




Image 58 - Products

Product import

The fields you fill in are:

Contents tab:

• TITLE - product name

It must not have the manufacturer, colour, code or any other information that exists in other fields. It must have symbols and capitals only at the beginning (or at the beginning of each word if it is a noun and a name), unless given in a specific way by the manufacturer.

• **TEXT** – product description

It needs to be plain text structured in sentences, with proper lowercase / uppercase that refers to the product. It must not be codes, the title to be repeated, the attributes and so on. Also, it must not contain information about the site (transport, offers and so on).

- **SEO** information used by the search engines.
- SUMMARY short description

Optional Fields Tab:

• String Field1 - you give the ID of a video you've uploaded to youtube to appear on the product page: Example: bitlps://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qnWQleTDSVM you must fill in the String Field1 field with the code after the =, ie qnWQleTDSVM

Attributes tab: product attributes

Documents Tab:

• Images: product image, dimensions 1000 x 1000 pixels

Variations tab: Product variations, see Add Variations section

- Settings:
 - o **ID** Unique product ID that is added automatically during the creation
 - Created at The date that the product was created (updated automatically)
 - o Modified at The date that the product was modified (updated automatically)



- Published to publish the product choose
- Category basic category that defines the type of the product

If the product does **not have variations**, please fill in the following **Settings**:

- Price: Product price
- Initial Price: Initial product price in case of discount
- **Discount:** Discount price, automatically fills the price field if no price is declared based on the initial price
- SKU: unique product code
- MPN: Model Part Number given to the product by the manufacturer
- Barcode: The barcode given by the manufacturer to the product

One of the UPC, EAN, GTIN-12, GTIN-13, GTIN-8, GTIN-14, JAN, ISBN (ISBN-13, ISBN-10), ITF-14. Almost always is the barcode present in the majority of products.

Add variations

Product variations are added from the **Variations** tab of the product page.

The attributes with which the variations are created are Color and Size.




Image 59 - Choice variation

If you want to have two levels of variations, firstly you add variations based on Color and then add the available sizes in each color.






Image 60 - Add variations

The values to be filled in are:

- Barcode: Barcode given by the manufacturer to the product
- SKU: Unique product code
- MPN: Model Part Number given by the manufacturer to the product
- Price: Product price
- Initial Price: Initial product price
- Published: To publish the product, click on the red icon to be changed to green
- Stock: The stock of the product. If the stock is 0, the product will not appear in the e-Shop.

NOTE: Values filled in the Settings are ignored and the values of the variations are applied.

Members

To view the details of the users who have been registered in the e-shop or have placed an order as guests, select **E-Shop> Members** from the main menu.

By selecting the edit button in a member, you can view its information and its orders that has placed. By clicking on the order number, you can view the information of that order.




Image 61 - Membership details



Orders

Orders placed in the e-Shop are displayed in the section **E-Shop > Orders.**




Image 62 - Orders

By selecting the edit button of an order, you can see its details.




Image 63 - Order details

You can change the status of the order to **SENT** or **CANCELED** and after saving you will get a message to send an informative email to the customer. In addition, by updating the **Voucher** field with the shipping code, it will be added to the email.

Coupon

To add a new coupon, click on the "Add" button.

A coupon consists of the following elements:




Image 65 - Voucher details

- **Code:** The coupon code that will be given to the customer to use in his purchases.
- Start At: Date from which the coupon will be valid.
- End At: Date until the coupon is valid.
- Amount: The amount of the discount
- **Amount Percent**: If "YES" is selected then the amount declared in the **Amount** field is a <u>percentage</u> <u>discount</u> on the total amount of the basket. If it is "No", then the discount amount is the <u>integer value</u> to be deducted from the basket's total.
- **Shipping Costs Discount**: When the value is "No", the discount is applied in the basket's total, excluding the shipping. If it is a "Yes" then the discount is applied in the shipping costs if there are any.
- **Published**: For the coupon to be active, the value «Yes» must be selected.
- Attributes: In the attributes tab, you can declare the characteristics that the products should have in order for the coupon to be valid. If no attribute is declared, then the coupon is valid for all the products in the e-Shop. If the coupon is declared for the shipping costs, then all the attributes are ignored.



Shipping

Shipping rules are declared in the section **E-Shop > Shippings**. Shipping costs are declared per location. For the declaration of locations, go to **E-Shop > Shippings > Locations**.




Image 66 - Shippings

To add a new location, select the **Add** button on the top right and fill in the fields:

- TITLE location name.
- Allow Pickup From Store select if you want to be able to pick up an order from a store.
- Allow Pay On Delivery choose if you wish to be able to pay on delivery.
- Published choose to publish the location in the e-Shop




Image 67 - Location

In Settings, fill in the fields:

- Shipping amount: the shipping cost
- Free shipping amount: you fill in the amount from which no shipping costs are charged.\

Users

To view the CMS users, navigate from the main menu in **Administration > Users.**






Image 68 - Users section

Edit user

By clicking the Edit button on a user's record, you can edit the data.

After making the modifications you want, press the button to save your changes. Otherwise, press the button Cancel to cancel the action and close the window.

Delete user

To delete a user, select the edit button to the left of the name, and on the new screen, select the button

Delete on the top right of the screen.



Site settings

To modify basic elements of the e-Shop, such as phone, email, social media, select from the main menu **Administration > Settings.**




Image 70 - Administration settings

- social.facebook: facebook url
- **social.youtube**: youtube url
- **shippingCosts.free:** you give the default price for which is free shipping is applied and is displayed in the informative verbals of the Homepage

The **seo.description**, **seo.keywords**, **seo.title** fields define the default values for description, title and keywords to be used by search engines eg google.

Clicking on the edit button of the field opens its edit page, which is shown in the picture below. From the fields, change <u>only</u> the Value field.
