Data Identification

- Teaching users how to find migrated content

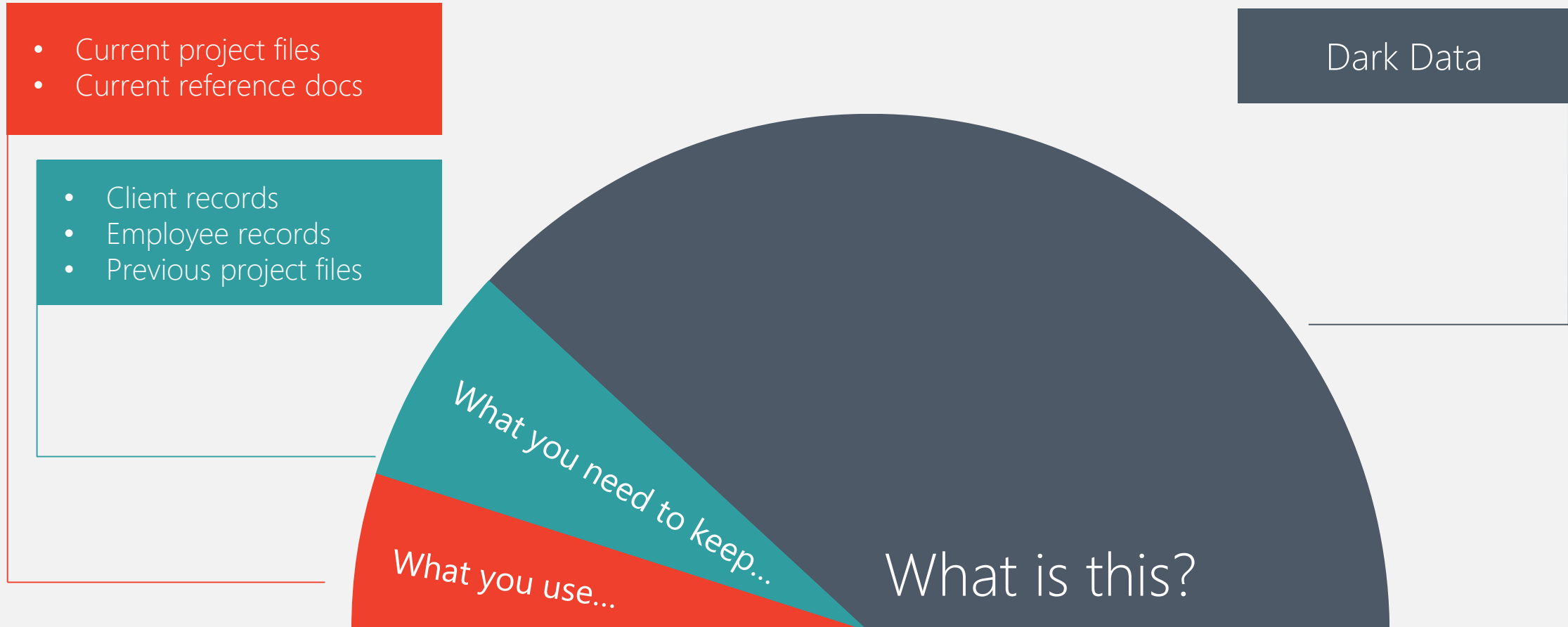


Validation of Content

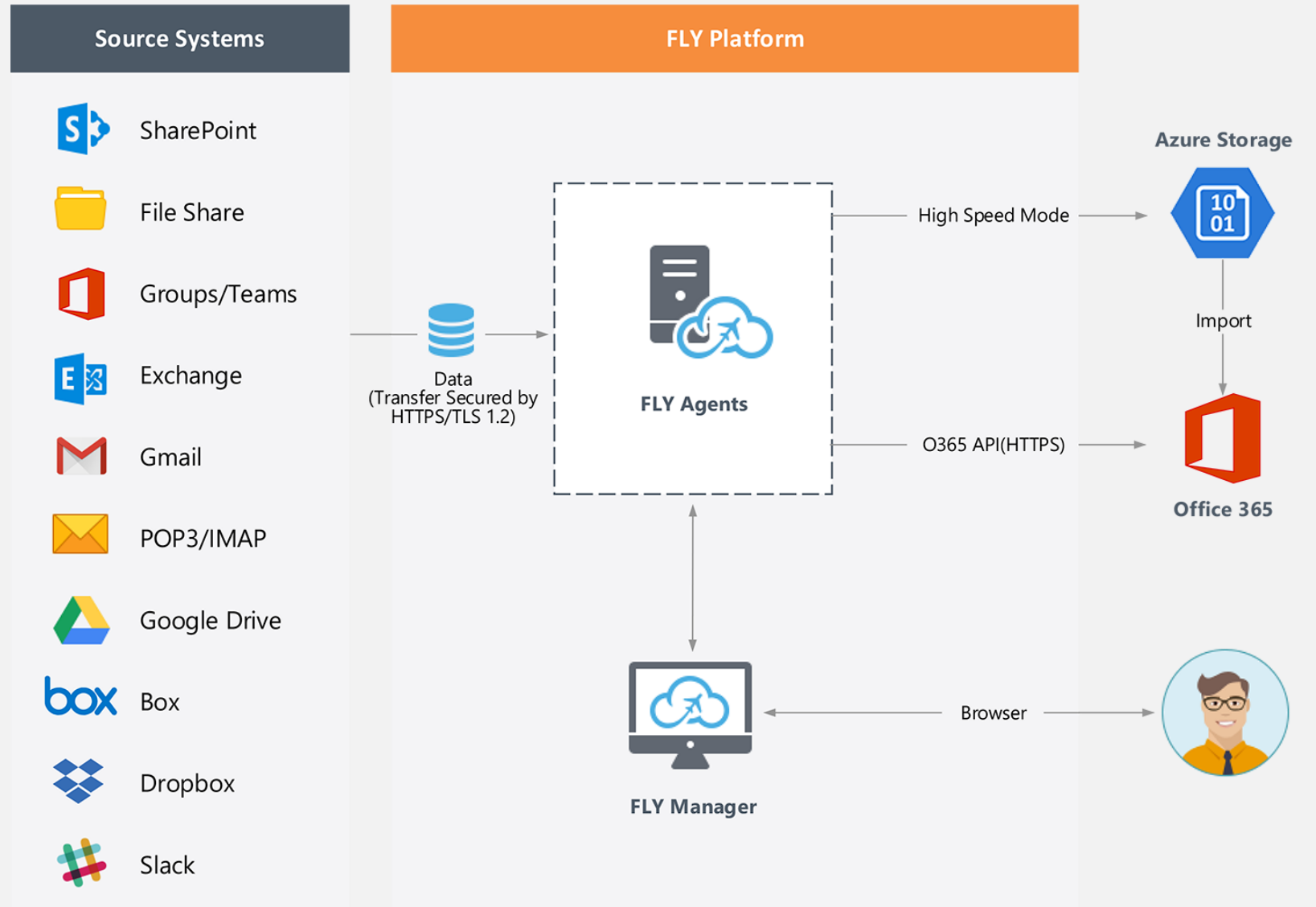

Merge one Office 365 tenant with another, or move content between tenants. Synchronize mailbox data between Exchange Online services across tenants, and migrate content, security, and metadata between SharePoint Online sites.

Mailbox Migration

Migrate users, groups, resources, shared and archived mailboxes from Exchange on-premises/Exchange Online to Exchange Online. Also migrate mails, contacts, tasks, and more from Gmail to Exchange Online.

Slack Migration

Migrate Slack channels, users, files, and conversations to Microsoft Teams.

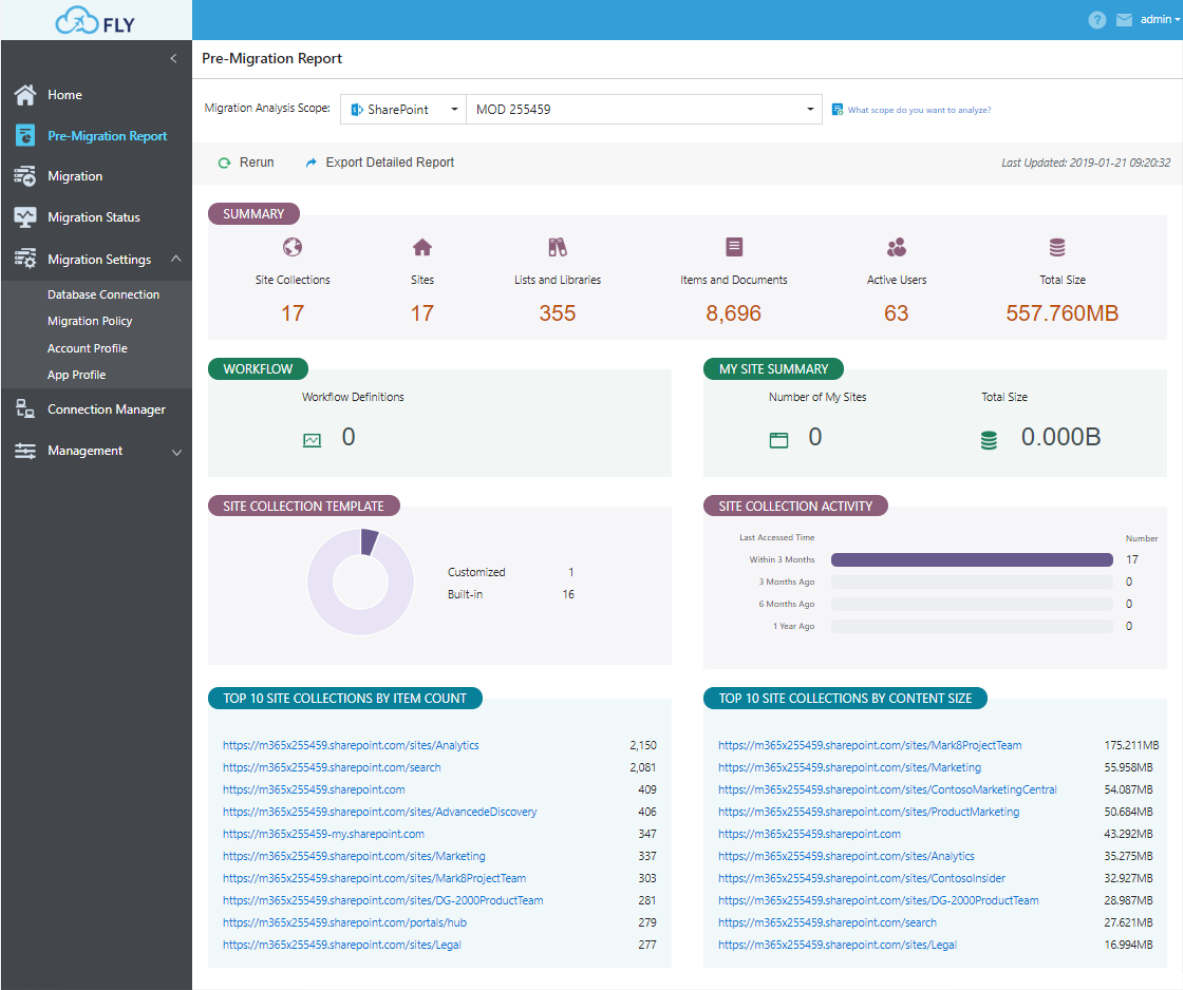
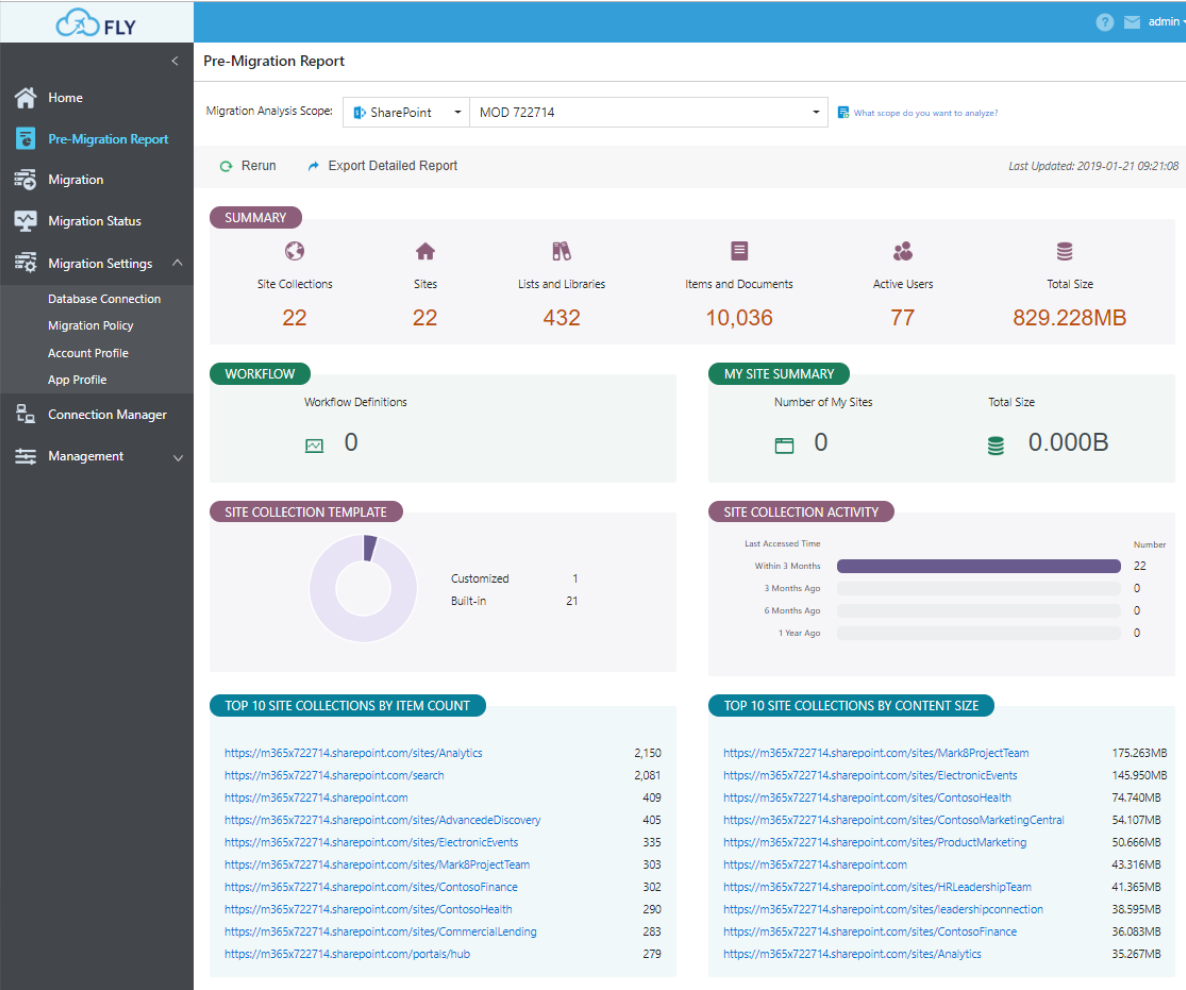
