That's where the Microsoft 365 roadmap comes in.


The roadmap is the central location for IT professionals, business decision makers, and anyone else who's interested, to see what's coming.



Here’s how we define each of these statuses:

Status	Description
In development	The feature is currently in development and testing, and is not available to customers
Rolling out	The feature is beginning to roll out to the <i>first</i> applicable customers and is not yet available to <i>all</i> applicable customers
Launched	The feature is available to all applicable customers




