

INSTALLATION & QUICK SETUP - IN Data Manager

This document indicates the steps to follow to generate a complete cycle of the IN Data Manager app.

Requisites

The IN Data Manager app must be installed for use IN Data Manager DK. You can install it from Microsoft AppSource through this link:

Change dashboard interface

The homepage related with the Data Manager interface can be changed as follows, if it is not already established:

On the top right corner search for a settings icon like in Figure 1 and click it.




Figure 2: My Settings

Then clicking on **My Settings** as shown in **Figure 2**, a new window will pop up.

On the Role Center (Figure 3) row, click the dots to unfold the list.

Create Customers for testing the IN Data Manager

In order to test the solution, we must have some data in system. For that action we will need to create a few customers.

On the right top corner, you can find a search button as in **Figure 5**. Click on it and type **customers**.

A list will appear with the search results. Click on the first row as shown in **Figure 6**.

The view related with the Customers will appear. The creation of a Customer is a very simple and fast process. Click on the New button (**Figure 7**) to display the Customer card in order to fill the customer data.

There is no need to fill all the details of the customer, but only the rows that have a red asterisk, as in **Figure 8**. If some other fields are required to complete the process the system will notify you with a message and will not let you proceed.

When the customer creation process concludes we can start the next process.

Changes Template Creation

On the main dashboard page, under the activities tab, there are the predefined templates. You can also define your own.

To do so click on Templates square (the number of templates might vary with the creation or deletion of the templates) like in **Figure 9**.

You will notice that there are already created templates, but it is not a relevant matter because we will create our own.

The next step to do is to click on the New button like in Figure 10.

After that you need to give the template a unique name.




Figure 11: Table Settings

Once the template is created the table settings must be set up. Select the desired template and on the top bar click the **Navigate button** -> **Table Settings**. The figure 11 shows the related buttons.

The level of knowledge needed to understand the setting table is more technical. To resume, all you have to do is select a table and the fields that you want to modify.

Under the **Tables** tab, click on the **TABLE ID. Row** and select the Customer table from the list which, in this case, is number **18**. Details are shown in **Figure 12**.

Under the **Fields** tab, click on the **FIELD NO. Row** to select the field from the previously chosen table. In this example the **Name** field was selected. **Figure 13** shows the rows with the details.

Changes Template Use

After the template creation is done, it can be used by clicking **on Navigate button -> Changes** or on **Navigate button -> Changes Matrix** as shown in **Figure 14**.

The only difference between the two options is the design.

After choosing the pattern you want to use for the data changes, you will have to click on **the Load Data to modify** button as shown in **Figure 15**.

If there is no data to load, the cause might be that there is no data in the desired table.

You can modify the records.

After finishing the modification process, you will have to save the changes by clicking on the **Save Data** in system button. **Figure 16** shows where the button is placed.

The process concludes with this last action. To see if the changes have been successfully done you can check the customer table (in this case) and compare the old and new results.

There is an option to revert the last changes made. In order to do so you must click **Navigate -> Changes Executed** as shown in **Figure 17**.

Deletions Template Creation

The process is the same as for **Changes Template Creation**, but instead of making changes, it deletes the registers. It also has a revert changes option to recover the last modification made.

Access to the template is done as shown in Figure 19.

Once you access the template area, the steps for the configuration are similar to the previous configured template.

In order to create a new Deletion template, click on New button as represented in Figure 20.

Remember to choose a unique name for the template.

Once that is done you have to set up the settings by clicking on **Navigate -> Table Setting** as shown in **Figure 21**.

Under the **Tables** tab, click on the **TABLE ID. Row** and select the Customer table from the list which is the number **18** in this case. Details are shown in **Figure 22**.

Deletions Template Use

After the template creation is done it can be used by clicking **on Navigate button -> Deletions** or on **Navigate button -> Deletions Matrix** as shown in **Figure 24**.

After the load data to delete process is finished, you will have to save the changes in system by clicking on the **Delete records from system** button as shown in **Figure 26**.

At the end of this action the records are deleted from system. To revert the changes you must click **Navigate -> Deletions Executed** as shown in **Figure 27**.

Also, a change not always can be reverted due to internal functionality of the solution in order to avoid inconsistencies of the data. This constraint is transparent for the user.
