## **Azure Virtual Desktop**



Azure Virtual Desktop (AVD), formally known as Windows Virtual Desktop (WVD), provides the ability to scale remote desktop in Azure, on-demand, without worry about managing traditional VDI components. AVD provides a secure, scalable, globally accessible remote desktop environment that integrates seamlessly with Azure and Azure AD. The C1 Azure Virtual Desktop (AVD) Proof of Concept is designed to get an organization utilizing AVD while leveraging next-gen Windows 10/11 persistent and multi-session desktops. The engagement starts by providing an overview of AVD and its capabilities, performing an AVD readiness assessment, and documenting prerequisites to perform the build-out. Users are granted access to remote desktops or remote applications based on Azure AD group membership. FSLogix and MSIX App Attach leveraging Azure Files are used to manage user profiles application containers.
