INTEGRATE YOUR VIDEO ROOMS WITH MICROSOFT TEAMS



Microsoft Teams is today the hub for many companies' collaboration between individuals and within workgroups. This is often done in digital meetings with chat, voice, screen sharing and video – whether communication takes place within the office or with participants elsewhere.

Enabling the video feature in Teams gives you a better sense of presence and a more efficient meeting. This applies both between PCs, mobile apps or via more dedicated video rooms.

Now there is the opportunity to integrate your traditional video rooms from e.g. Cisco and LifeSize with Microsoft Teams. This allows you to create a Teams meeting, where users in the office can participate from the video room and other users can participate via their mobile phones or computers. This allows you to effectively collaborate and meet both with people in the office and people who, for various reasons, must be involved remotely.

The Telio Teams Video Gateway service enables you to connect your video rooms with Microsoft Teams. It is cloud-based and the capacity can be easily dimensioned according to the number of video sessions desired.

Connect your video rooms to Teams

The service enables users to join the same Microsoft Teams meeting both from video room systems or from Teams clients and apps.

All video systems that support H323, WEB-RTC, and SIP are supported, which means that for example systems from Cisco, Lifesize, and Polycom work.

Easy to invite, easy to connect

Users create a Microsoft Teams meeting in the same way as normal. Some extra info about how to connect will automatically be provided in the meeting invitation in Outlook.

This means that users do not have to keep track of different booking systems or handling. They book a regular Teams meeting, and then participants can join from their video system or from their Teams client.

From Cisco's video system, the connection can be done automatically with one click or manually with a specified conference ID in the meeting invitation.

In addition to participants being able to see each other via video, you can also share documents and whiteboards from Teams clients or through the video systems.

Dimensioned by concurrent sessions

The service is priced according to the number of concurrent sessions. It is purchased in packages of 5 sessions.

The following requires a session:

- The company's internal video system
- External video systems

The following does not require a session:

- Users participating from the Teams client or Team app
- Microsoft Teams Room System or Microsoft Collaboration bars
- External participants who connect through the web-based Teams client

Target group

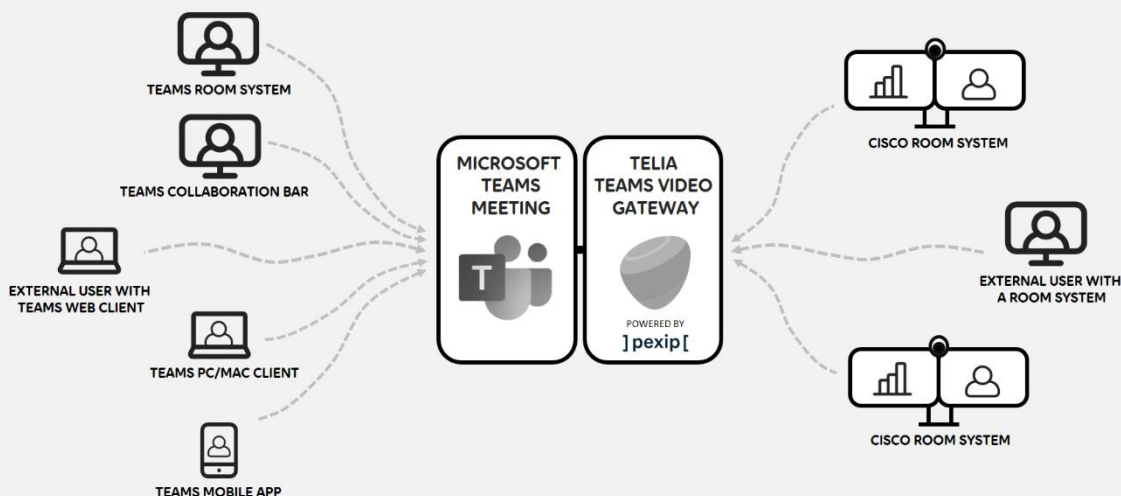
The service is aimed for companies with more than 5 video rooms
