In addition, these children have the following characteristics:

- Behavioral disorders resulting from disability to understand verbal communication.
- A limited understanding of verbal instructions (1 or 2 words maximum) which must be supported by a visual material.

HelpictoTM uses this information to retrieve the appropriate images from its database. For example, the question, "*Do you want to eat an apple?*" produces pictures of the child, the action of eating, and an apple, along with on-screen buttons for "*yes*" and "*no*".


