These were the questions that we promised a follow up to during the live webinar:

Question: Can we link Power Automate with ADP? I heard we linked to over 300 connectors, so is ADP one of them?

Answer: ADP is not a current connector and no word on if it is on the roadmap.

Question: As a connector developer, what are some opportunities for the promotion of our product inside Power Automate platform?

Answer: There is no promotion opportunity, but you can go through the process of <u>registering your</u> <u>custom connector</u> to be featured in the Power Automate service for all users after the Microsoft review process.

Question: Can you share links to any learning material?

Question: Can the approval process be sent to a shared Outlook mailbox? If yes, can you point us to source material on how to apply this?

Answer: Yes, by default it does send via email. Here is some documentation: https://docs.microsoft.com/en-us/power-automate/modern-approvals

Question: Are there any new, non-premium connectors in the pipeline?

Answer: We do not provide a roadmap for connectors. The <u>current list of available connectors</u> is through the product. Also, you can <u>create a flow which notifies</u> you whenever new connectors are added.

Question: A multi-select option set created in Power Apps doesn't show in Power Automate – will that be fixed soon?

Answer: Thank you for raising this question. The product team is looking into a fix. However, we do not have a timeline for when this will be complete.

Question: Do we have a CI/CD approach available to transfer the changes between environments? **Answer**: Thank you for raising this question. The product team is looking into a fix. However, we do not have a timeline for when this will be complete.
