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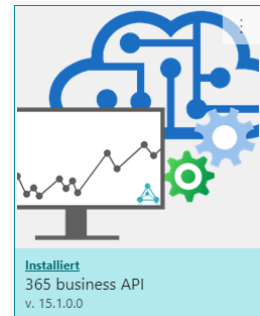


Introduction

The 365 business API app is designed to provide base communication methods to the 365 business API services and implements basic setup and API key (used for authentication) registration.

What is the 365 business API?

The 365 business API is a collection of web services based on the latest and most advanced technologies that you can integrate into your business application.



What Services are provided by the 365 business API?

The 365 business API provides a growing number of functionalities and services to support your business. Currently the 365 business API is providing data quality services, e.g. Address Validation, PDF signing and manipulation services and many more.

What is the purpose of the 365 business API app?

The 365 business API app is providing base connection interfaces to interact with 365 business API services, like Elster ERiC Sales VAT Adv. Notification, PDF manipulation or Barcode creation and decoding.

Additionally this app is guiding you through the registration process to gather an evaluation license for free of charge usage of 365 business API services and providing the ability to upgrade your license for a unrestricted pay-as-you-go subscription.

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The 365 business API app is the base component for using other 365 business API services, like Address Validation, Document Recognition or Barcode creation.

To get started you first need to setup your personal API authentication key.



Please note:

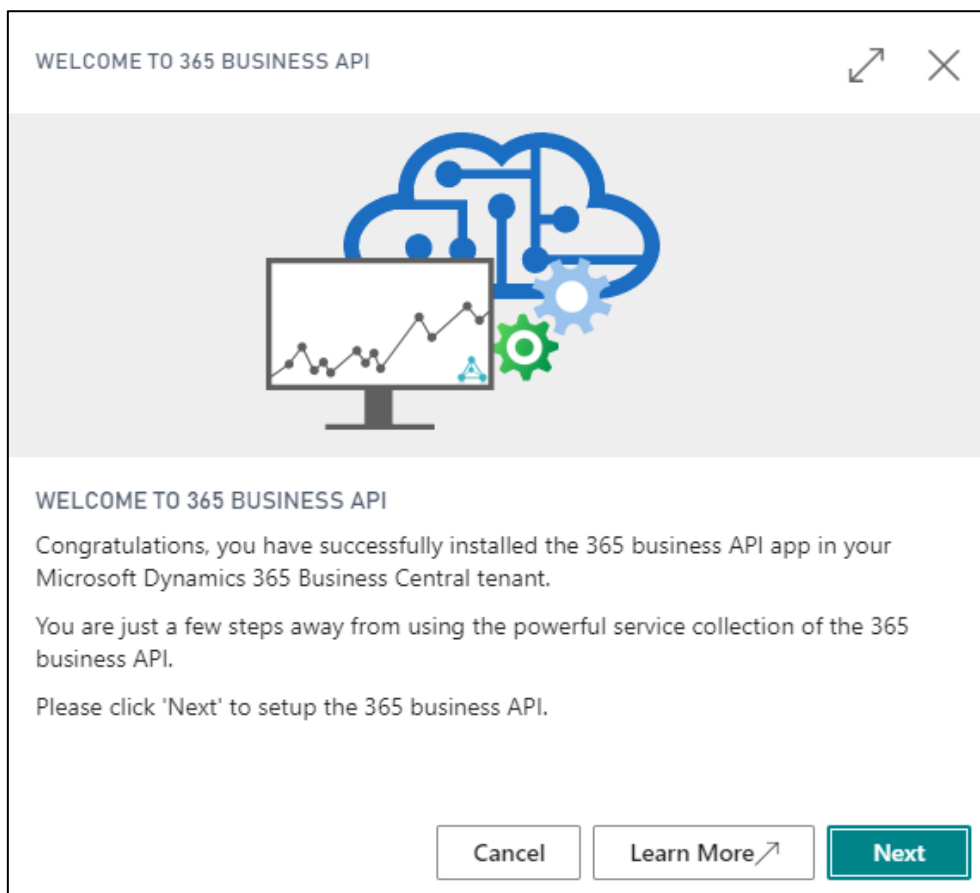
By registering with the 365 business API, you start with a free and non-binding 30-day trial period.

After the trial period you can decide for yourself how to proceed.

There are no costs for you!

First start

After successful installation of the app, a welcome wizard appears at first login which provides a short introduction and helps with the setup.





Note:

The welcome wizard only appears once, after the successful installation! To run the wizard again, run the page action **Start Welcome Tour** at the **365 business API Setup** page.

Registration

The following walkthroughs are describing the **Registration** process for the 365 business API in Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central.

Assisted Setup

1. On the Role Center, click the **Setup & Extensions** dropdown.
2. Click **Assisted Setup**.

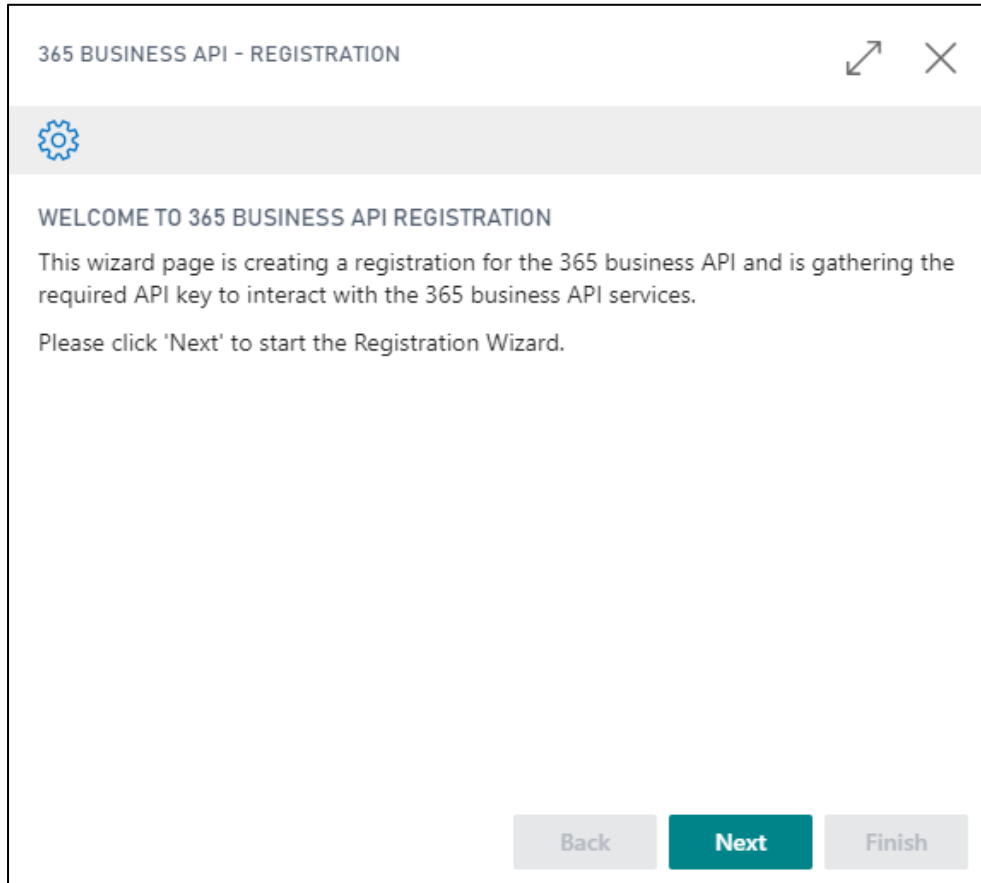
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
Registration Wizard

3. Read and Accept the **Privacy Statement** by clicking on the toggle button


4. Read and Accept the License Agreement (EULA) by clicking on the toggle button




