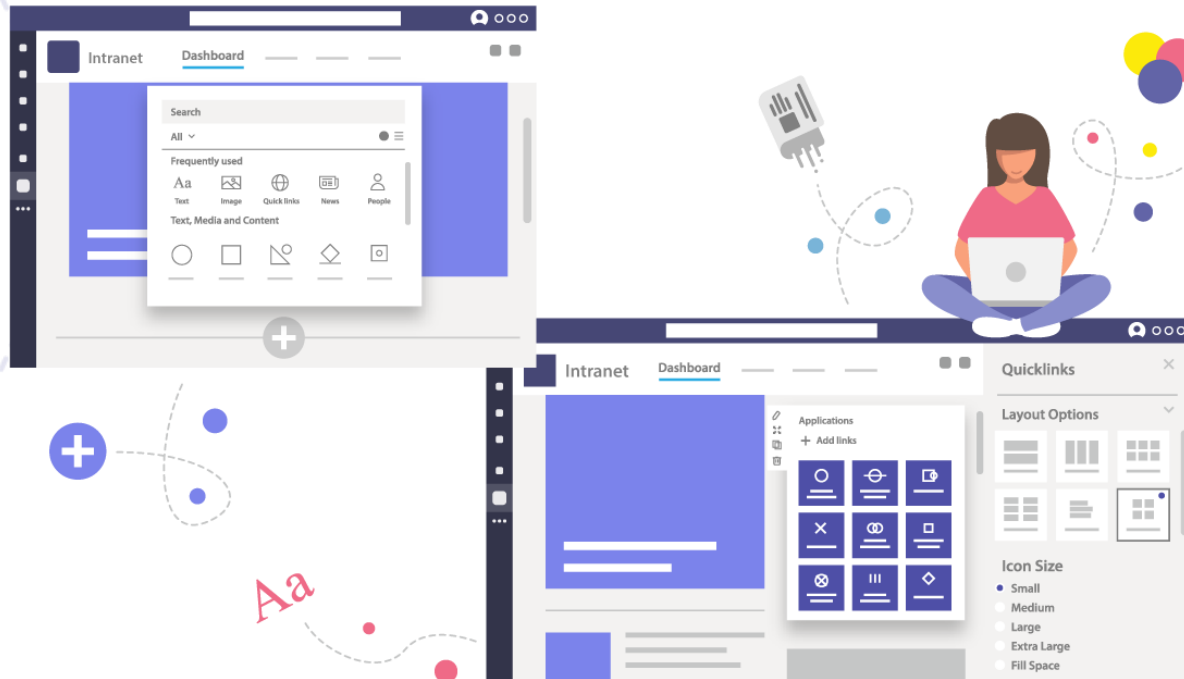
Three Layout Templates

Choose from three pre-defined layout templates and get started immediately.

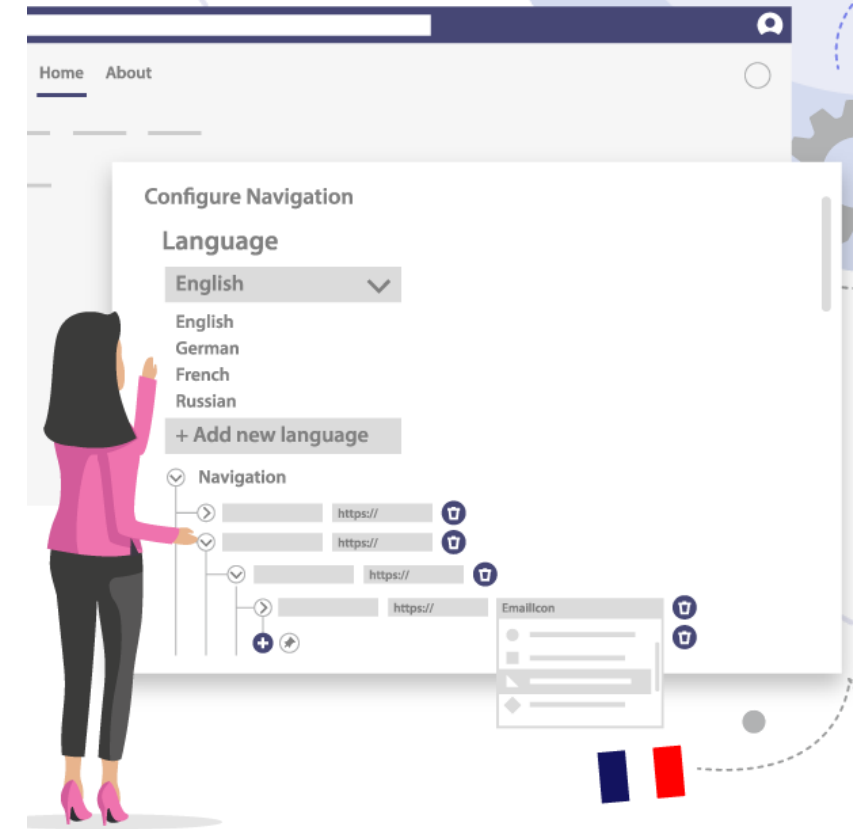


Setup & Edit in Teams

Create and edit your intranet directly in Microsoft Teams. Add new content, customize the layout and change the design to match your branding.




Set up the navigation for the mega menu also directly in Teams. Add internal or external links in up to four levels and customize each link with an icon.
