

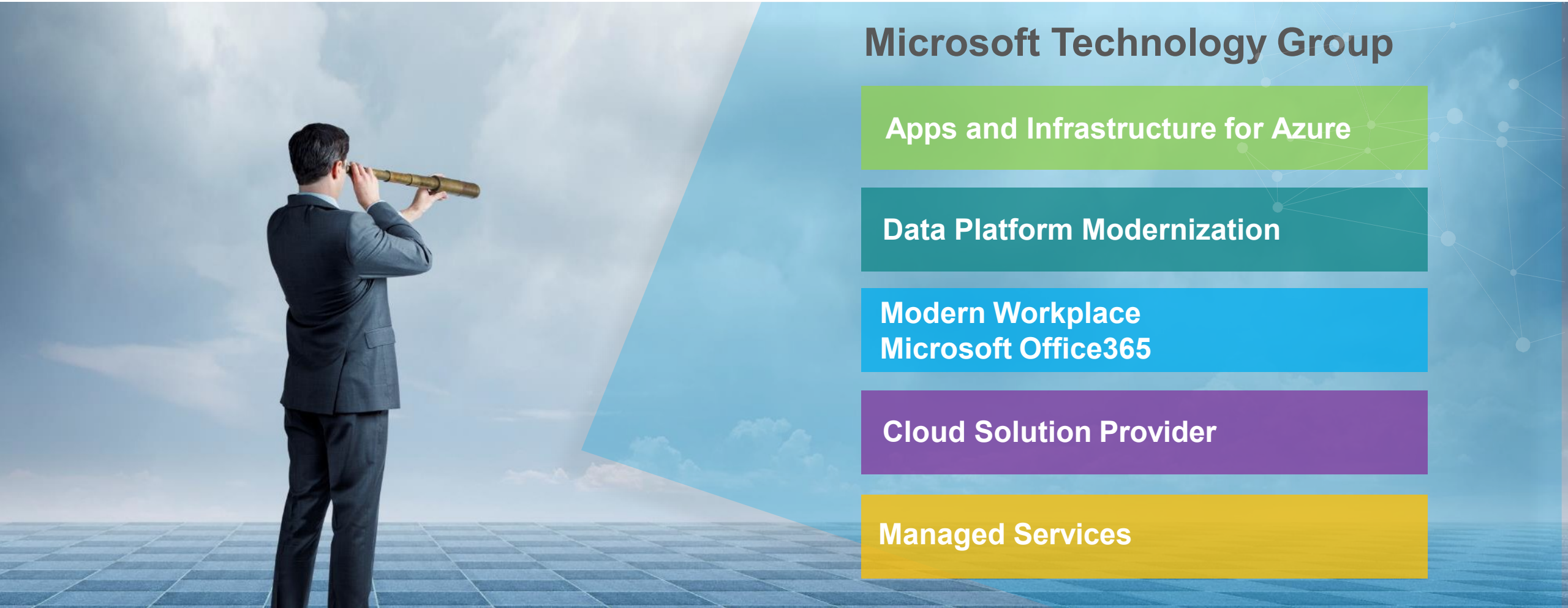

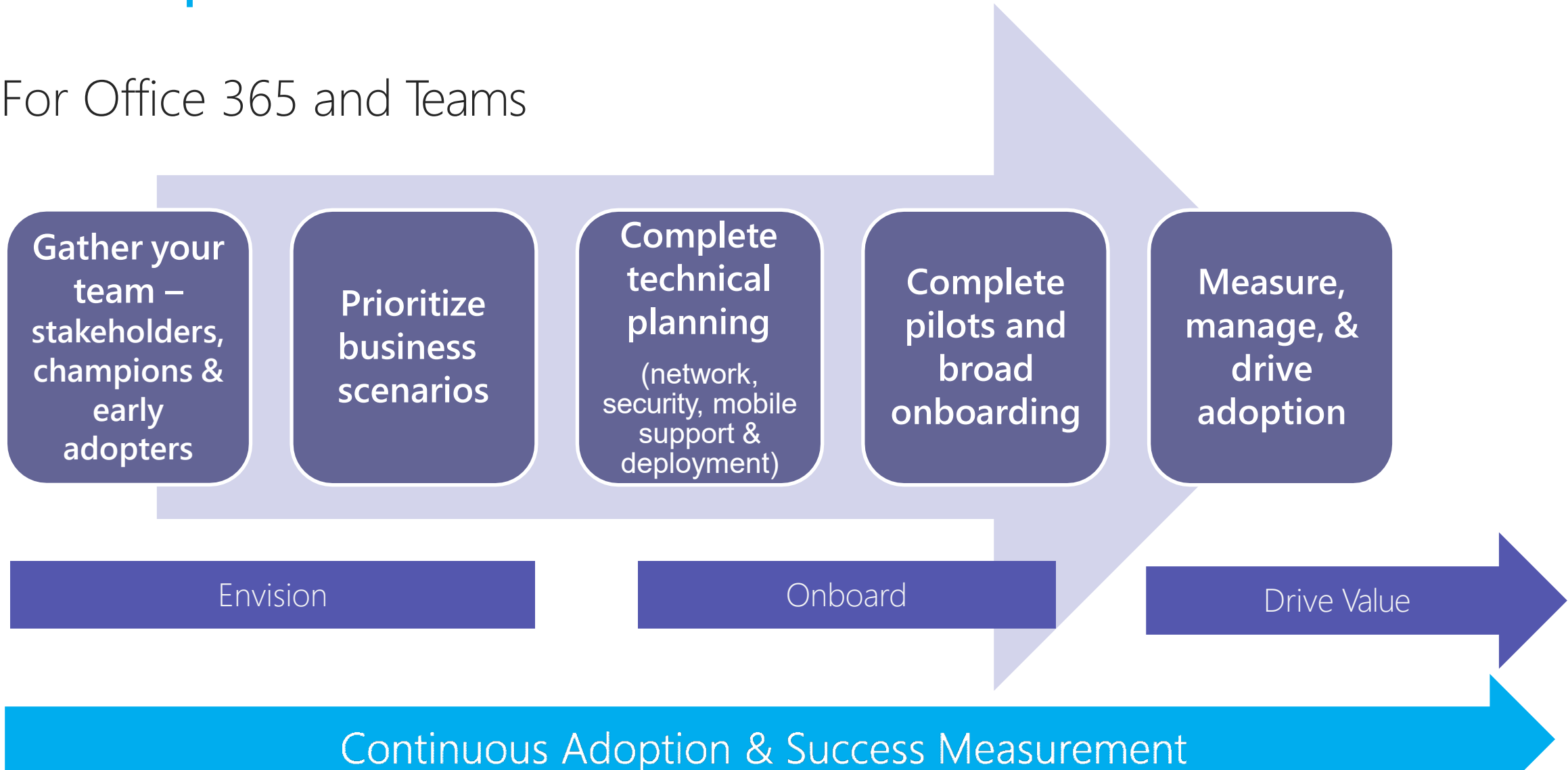

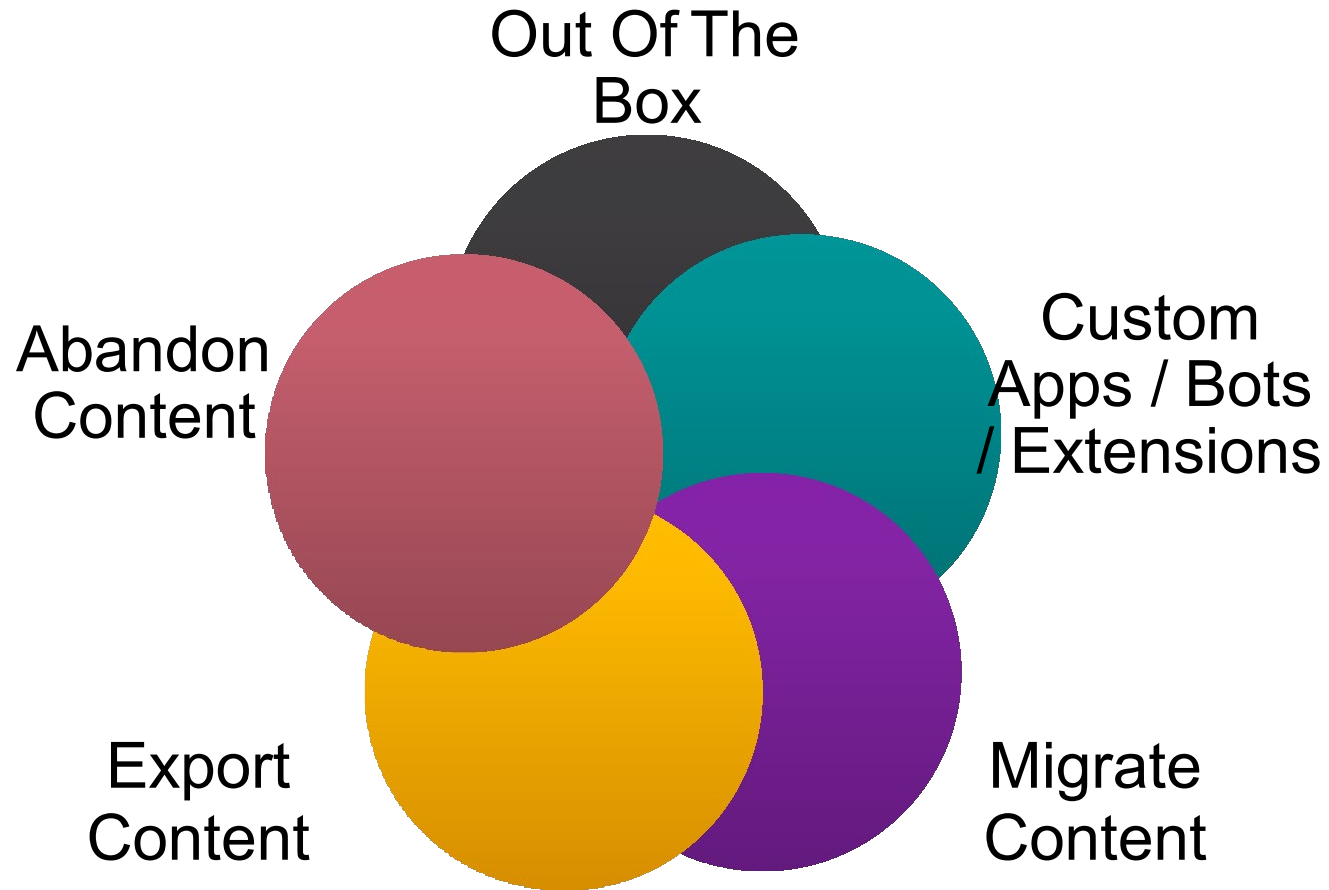

Case Study – Slack to Teams Migration

Slack to Teams Migration Project

- Over 5K Slack Enterprise users, over 18K channels in Slack
- Approximately \$2M / year in Slack cost
- Teams has been deployed but Slack is integral to working life and numerous business processes
- Over 65 Custom developed integrations with Slack as well as OOTB applications
- Microsoft account team engaged Spyglass to help client understand what it would take to get those users converted
- Deployed our tool to conduct the discovery and provide insight into what customizations had been deployed
- Engaged our team as a Program Management Office including PM, BA, Arch, SharePoint, Teams and Azure Devs to drive the process in conjunction with their internal team

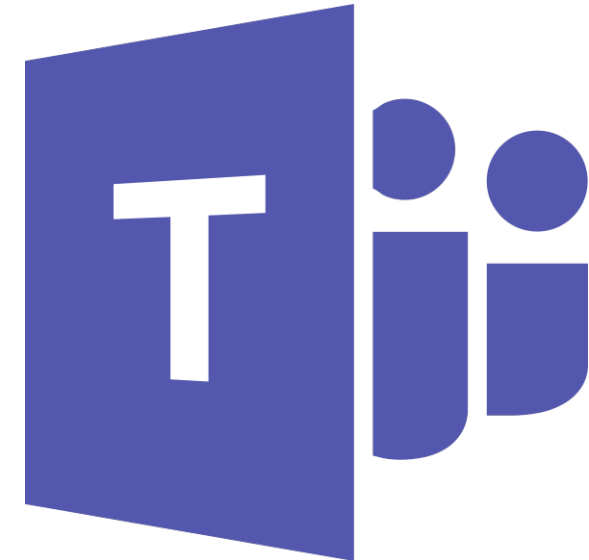

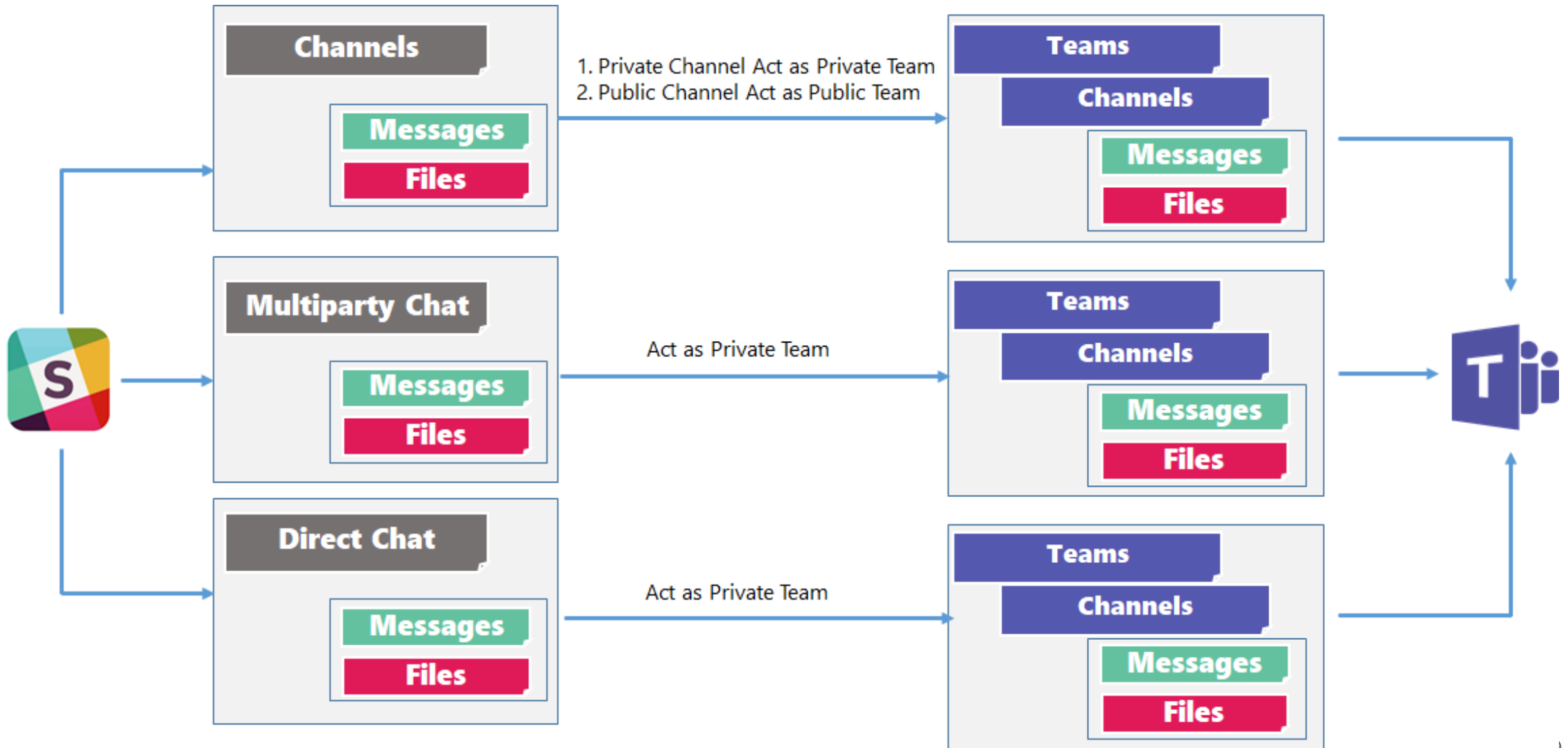

Observations

- High Level:
 - Slack users have done a lot of work on Slack to make it work for them and like its usability
 - Never feature for feature, some more, some less, but our focus is on supporting and optimizing how your users work
 - Need Executive Buy In to drive process
- Process:
 - Discover all the business processes that are dependent on Slack and provide new customization or workaround
 - Managing multiple workstreams and development processes with Client Dev Team
 - Determine what features are truly business critical
 - Provide documentation/guidance on best usage of Teams
 - Respond to the “Get to Know Teams” channels to help users understand what they can do in Teams
