




Get prepared

The Requirement

Transport Manager Jed Keetch, searched for a vehicle camera and tracking provider for his business to specifically improve overall fleet efficiency, visibility of location, decrease fuel costs and protect against fraudulent insurance claims. Previous processes involved relying upon drivers reporting via mobile phones upon daily activity and future planning. This process was time intensive and open to ambiguity.

The key determinant was that Foresolutions' MD, Tom Ross fully examined the range of solutions available based upon Jed's specific requirements, taking the time to prepare the best options for K Coghlan, so that Jed felt comfortable with the proposals put forward.

The Foretrack Difference

The improvement was instantaneous and present throughout the entire fleet operations.

Jed recognised the requirement for both internal and external cameras to protect against fraudulent claims by providing cast iron evidence, a particular concern due to size of the K Coghlan fleet. However there are other benefits to vehicle cameras. In essence the cameras became a fuel saving device themselves, as it was common for drivers the leave the vehicles idling whilst on lunch, the presence of the cameras stopped this immediately.

Routing more efficiently became part of the day-to-day operation, not only saving fuel but also time. Evidence of this was found in a commonly used route, where an alternative journey was planned, initially saving just under 2 miles per journey but 15 minutes in time. This route was taken 4 times per day, so the impact of the monetary saving was easily visible but the effect of saving 1 hour of driving / driver time had a much larger positive effect on the business.

Driver behaviour has improved also, where the Foretrack system provides telematics and flags excessive speeds, harsh braking, extended idling etc. Jed is able to review these actions with the driver involved and identify training or development, which in turn prevents future misdemeanours occurring.

An increase in the quality of customer service also became apparent. Where the previous process couldn't determine exact pick up times, the Foretrack system allowed customers to benefit from greater accuracy of the fleet's location.

Most notably as Transport Manager, Jed was able to rely on the Foretrack technology to report the key aspects raised in this case study, which meant he was able to spend more time on alternative parts of his role.

Police Evidence

As with most fleets; incidents and accidents on the road are commonplace. One such event involved the police requiring evidence of verbal and pre-incident activity. The vehicle cameras (both external and internal) recorded driver conversations outside of the vehicle including important still photography and the tracker log provided information on speeds and braking.

This meant that the traffic officers were fully armed with evidence in favour of K Coghlan.
