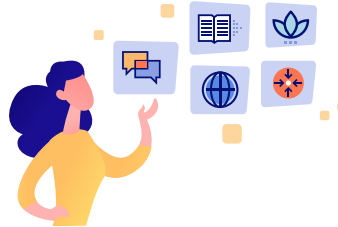

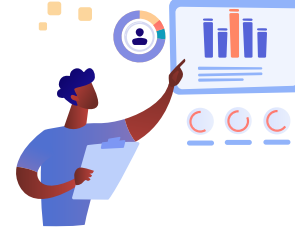
MANAGE USER ACCESS
