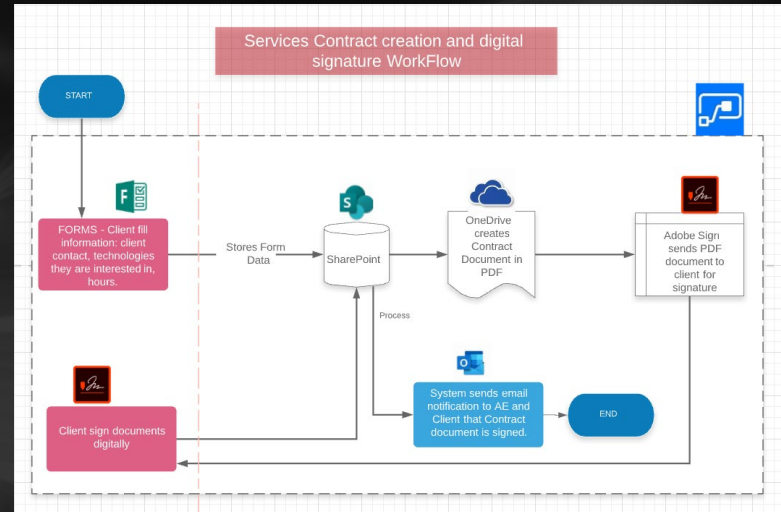

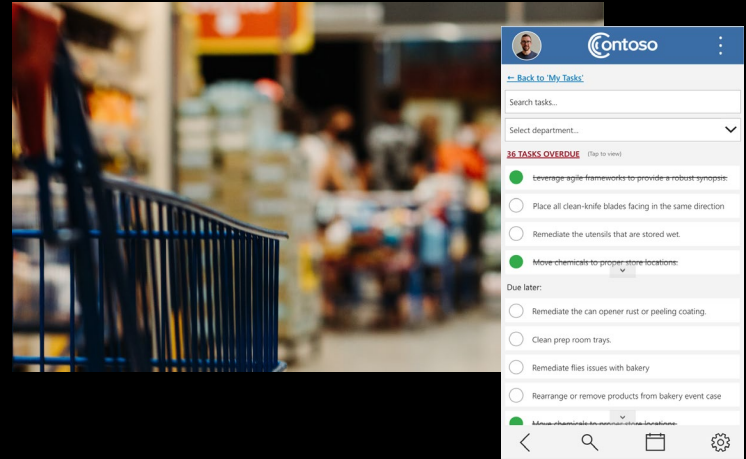
Major Supermarket Chain

The challenge

A large supermarket chain requires stores to complete hundreds of compliance, food safety, stocking, and marketing tasks daily and needed to replace an expensive and far too complex subscription-based software system. Additionally, the central office wanted a simple system, which they could distribute tasks on an individual department or store basis for employees.
