The COVID-19 pandemic has made us all much more aware of the importance of hygiene and cleanliness.

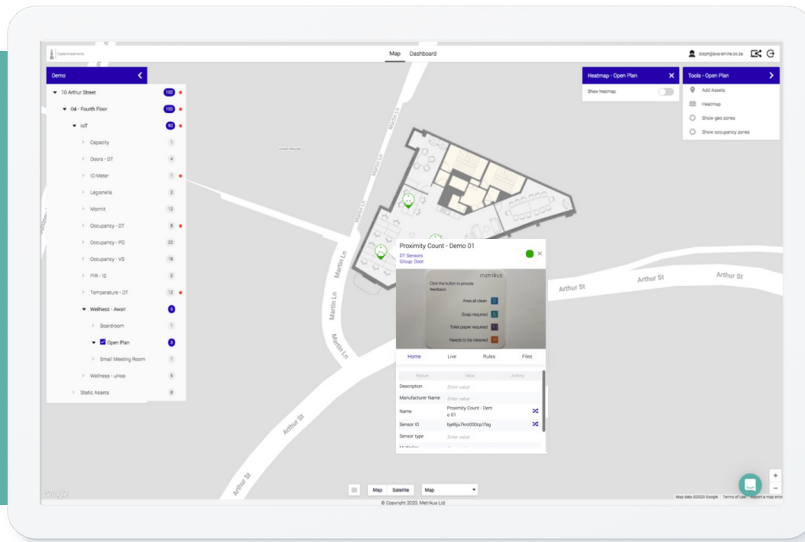

The challenges

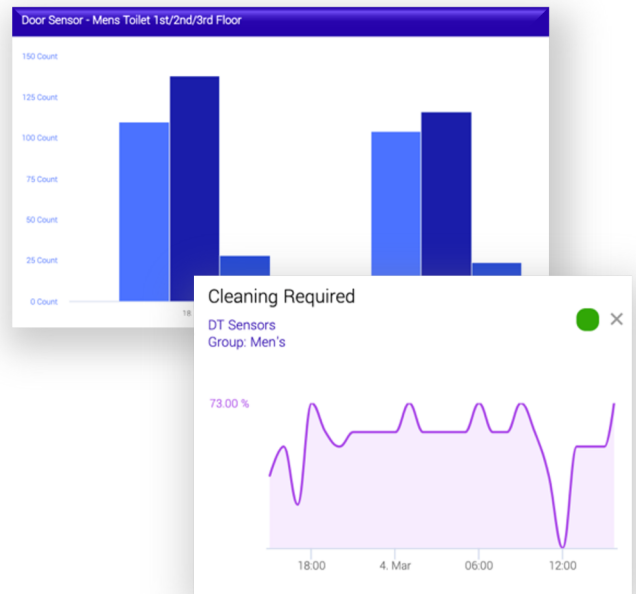


- Cleaning tends to be scheduled whether the space has been used or not
