

Please read the following prerequisites for the Teams Phone Pilot Engagement by Noventiq

- 1. The pilot is free of charge for customers who meet the eligibility criteria only. Customer is subject to eligibility check before being approved for Teams Phone pilot engagement.
- 2. The pilot scope can be implemented in a duration of 30 days to 90 days maximum.
- 3. Licensing: The eligible customer for Teams Phone Pilot with Total Voice should have:
 - Active Microsoft 365 Tenant and subscription with Microsoft Teams.
 - A 90-day trial of Teams Phone Standard license will be provided if the customer has a qualified Microsoft 365 plan.
 - Qualified Microsoft/Office 365 plans for the Teams Phone trial are:
 - ✓ Microsoft 365 Business Basic
 - ✓ Business Standard
 - ✓ Business Premium
 - ✓ Microsoft E3, or Microsoft A3
 - ✓ Office 365 F3, E1, E3, A1, or A3
 - ✓ Teams Essentials
- 2. Define and deliver the following information of the user accounts hosted in the Tenant that will be enabled for telephony:
 - Username
 - User Principal Name (UPN)
- 3. Have the TEAMS service operational and install the TEAMS application on the computers of the users who will take part in the PoC.
- 4. If DID is to be used, please supply the local (city) of the desired number.
- 5. Provide credentials for a user with Global Administrator permissions in Microsoft/Office 365 Tenant or support with access during deployment.
 - > Allow remote access for **NOVENTIQ** personnel for the respective configurations.
 - Assign a <u>Project Leader</u>, who will be the communication channel between **NOVENTIQ** and the Customer. The following information is needed:
