What was the opportunity...

- The client was running a live ERP system aimed towards offering a unified e-platform for managing the human resources of a major government entity in the Middle East. This included a centralized database of all government employee's information which provides multiple HR services serving 40+ entities and 50k+ employees.
- The client wished to secure the platform by extending it with Microsoft Azure's Disaster Recovery solution.
