
#### Third-party apps

Accessible by users in Teams





# 1 Identify relevant third-party apps for Teams


#### 450+ third-party apps available in Teams app store and more on the way....



### Identify relevant third-party apps

From Manage apps page in the left navigation of the Microsoft Teams admin center

Review the apps available in the catalog




### Identify relevant third-party apps enabled for single sign on

From the <u>Azure portal</u>, Azure Active Directory tab, choose Enterprise Applications

Review web applications in your app catalog already enabled for Azure Active Directory.

These are perfect candidates to bring into Teams.



# 2 Manage access to apps for Teams


### Manage organizational access

From <u>Manage apps page</u> in the left navigation of the Microsoft Teams admin center

View org-level status and properties of apps

Manage org-wide app settings

Manage tenant app catalog by blocking or allowing apps at the org level



# 3 Assign permissions

### Assign permissions


From <u>Permission policies page</u> in the left navigation of the Microsoft Teams admin center

Create and edit an app permission policy

Assign a custom policy to block or allow apps for specific users

Assign access to specific users

Alternatively, assign <u>access to groups by using</u> <u>PowerShell controls</u>



4 Enable users to collaborate with apps


### Control how users find apps

From <u>Setup policies page</u> in the left navigation of the Microsoft Teams admin center

Control which apps you pin to app bar and set order

Control whether users can pin apps to Teams

Install apps on behalf of users (preview) and choose which apps are installed by default




### Communicate app availability

Click on the icon below and customize the email template to let users know their accounts have been enabled. Add additional corporate guidance as you see fit.





