- Intake assessment module. The module features a single, online client application for all HHS programs, including Medicaid, both MAGI and non-MAGI, SNAP, TANF, CHIP and qualified health plans, enabled with SSA, federal DSH, IRS, and more. Clients experience a streamlined, user-friendly registration and change-of-circumstance processes that save time and reduce the likelihood of error. This module also supports automated eligibility determination, where allowed, which means less staff time spent sorting through applications and enrollment processes, freeing up staff to work on complex cases.
- Enrollment module. This module allows for real-time processing and enrollment management, including overrides, re-determinations, renewals and more, and integrates with the qualified health plans unique to each state. We can integrate with or incorporate your current state-based exchange to provide a more seamless eligibility and enrollment experience for beneficiaries.
- Eligibility determination module. This is a configurable rules engine pre-loaded with federal rules for HHS programs, including Medicaid, SNAP, TANF, CHIP and QHP, that may be adjusted to meet state interpretation while accommodating state-specific rules. This module can also be used for benefit screening as well as full eligibility determination.
- Benefit management module. This agency portal user interface allows case
 workers to manage their daily work through a configurable dashboard and
 workflow tool. This module enables staff to view case and client application
 details and manage the complete lifecycle of the case, from determination,
 change of circumstance and more.

- Qualified health plan shopping and plan management module. This module

- Reporting and analytics module.
