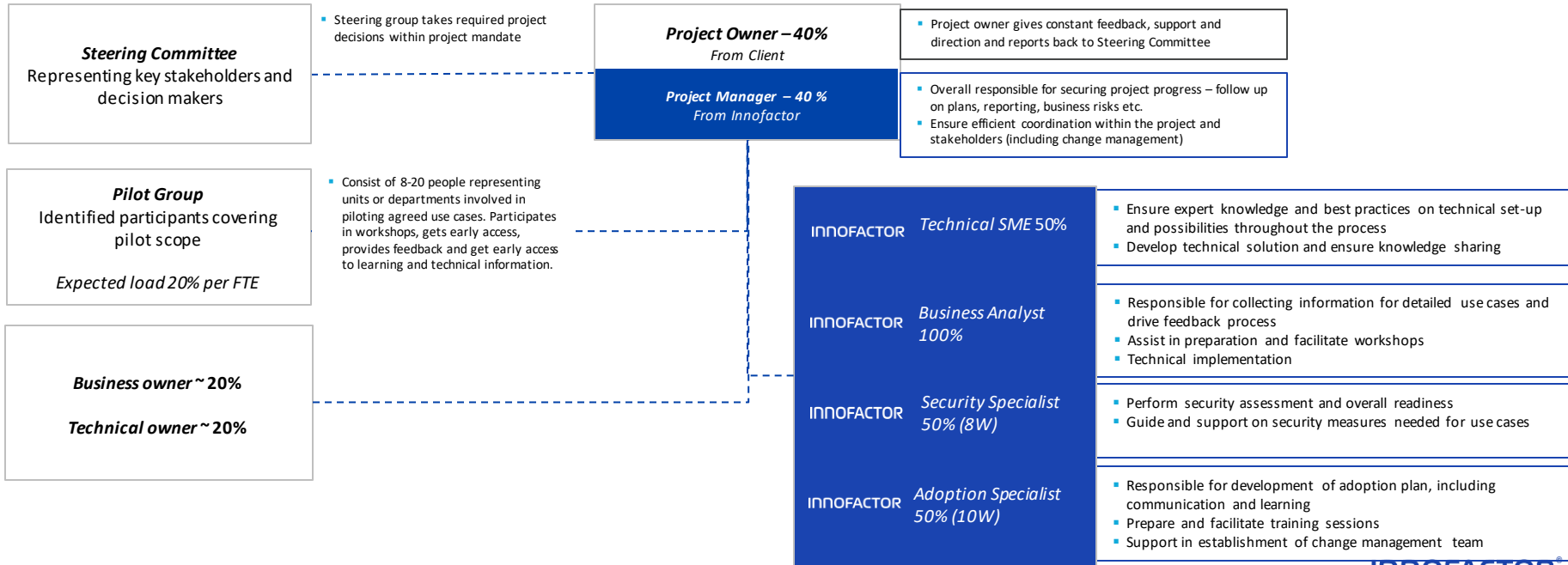
Organizational roll-out
