Service Introduction

Redoflow NAV to Business Central cleanstart is designed to ensure an effective and smooth transition from old Dynamics NAV ERP-system to Dynamics 365 Business Central. Redocap Oy will complete the deployment with the client using proven and standardized methods and strong experience of the deployments.

As Dynamics NAV ERP-system is coming to the end of its' lifetime, it is essential to be able to effectively deploy a new system. Redocap Oy offers clear methods and strong expertise. Redoflow NAV to Business Central Cleanstart is separated to four stages: assessment, implementation, training and deployment.

Stage 1: assessment

The client's business, operations and processes assessed and reviewed during the assessment stage. The goal of the stage is to reach a complete and clear picture of the operations as a whole, requirements for the new system and possible development during the implementation stage.

Stage 2: implementation

Redocap Oy will create a new Business Central environment for the client. The environment is setup according to the specifications made during the assessment stage. Setups include i.a. General ledger, finances, sales, purchases, inventory and Finnish localization. Implementation stage also includes the migration of necessary Master data, for example customers, items and vendors.

Stage 3: training

Redocap's experts will train the client's staff according to the needs. In minimum, training stage includes the basic training for Business Central, focusing on the key differences between NAV and Business Central.

Stage 4: deployment

Redocap will be assisting and supporting the client for the whole duration of go-live. Standardized methods and on-call support ensures that the go-live transition will go smoothly and no unnecessary interruptions are caused to business operations.

In cleanstart, the client's NAV environment is not copied as a new Business Central environment. The business Central environment is implemented in a way that only critical and necessary functions are preserved from the old system, taking advantage of Business Central's functionality and developing more efficient processes during the implementation.
