In this document is introduced Redocap Ltd. Process consulting models and results. ## Service Introduction

The assessment is separated to three stages: assess, SWOT-analysis, and requirements mapping.

#### Stage 1: Assess

A two-hour long meeting with the agenda of going through the client's business, operations, processes and needs. The goal is to get a clear of the functions that are required from the new system.

#### **Stage 2: SWOT-analysis**

A SWOT-analysis is created based on the assessment meeting. The SWOT-analysis includes all the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats which the customer may face during the acquirement and implementation of a new system. The aim of SWOT-analysis is to give a clear picture of what needs to be considered on a high level when looking for a new system.

#### Stage 3: Requirements mapping

During requirements mapping, all the client's operations are reviewed on a visual map. The map presents all the operational areas, their relations to each other, and the requirements for each area. The Requirements map can be used as a directive document for the acquirement of a new system.
