When you're ready to get started, here are the steps to follow:


Create an account with AssetAccountant and invite the relevant team members to the Organisation

- Once you have created your account, add the other users from your business:
  - » you can do this from Organisation Settings > Users.



## Set up the register that you want to work with and invite the relevant users

Select "Create register" and fill in the required details for the register.



In Register Settings > users you can invite other users to the register. Make sure you select the correct roles for your users:

- Register Guests have "Read only" access
- Register Users can manage the asset data (add, edit, delete) in the register
- Register Managers can manage settings and invite other users



#### Import your data

You will need to import the existing data for your assets from a spreadsheet - you can download both the import template for you to use and also the "cheat sheet" of the data that is mandatory for the import from the Add Assets > File Import > Downloads menu item. Note that if you have this in a spreadsheet already you can use that rather than having to put it in the template.

#### **Set up your Asset Groups**

Once the data has been imported, you'll be able to go into each Asset Group Screen and set

- 1. the default depreciation for each group and
- 2. the mappings to the GL in Sage Intacct note you can copy these across from another group and just amend the accounts that are different for each screen.
