

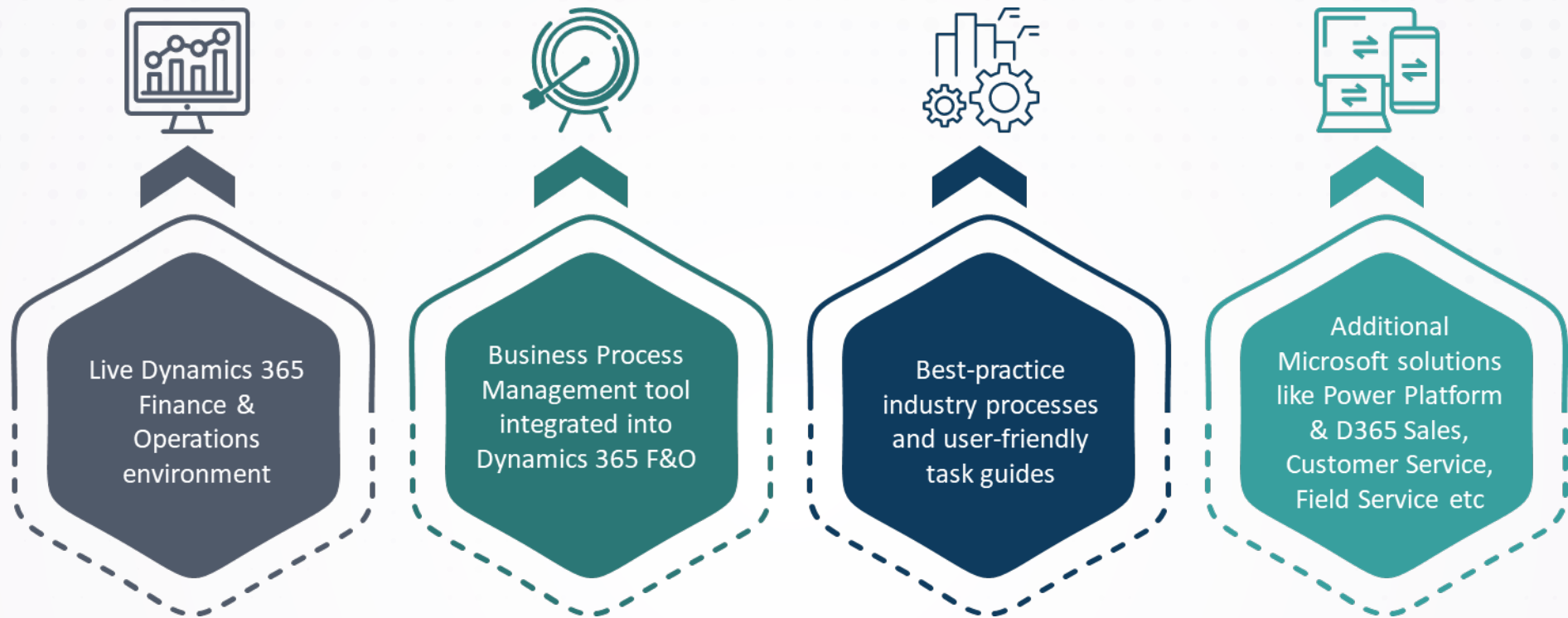

Training Day 1:

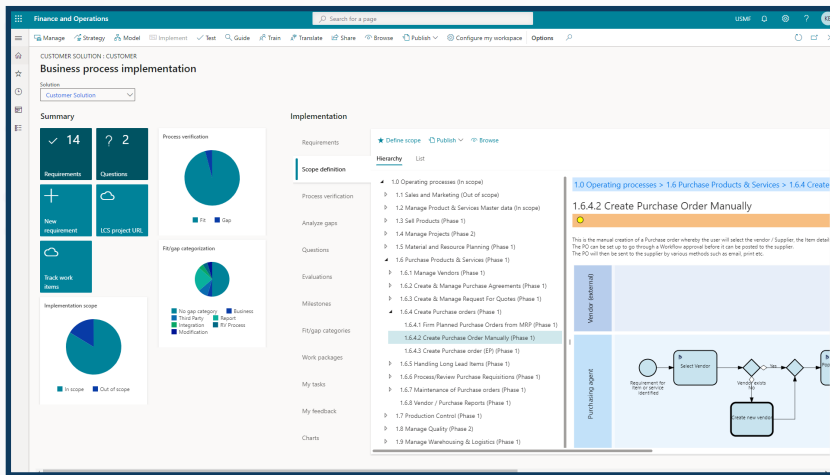

In between Training 1 and 2 :

You use the gap between the 2 days of training to examine the process library and determine which processes you would like to cover on Day 2.

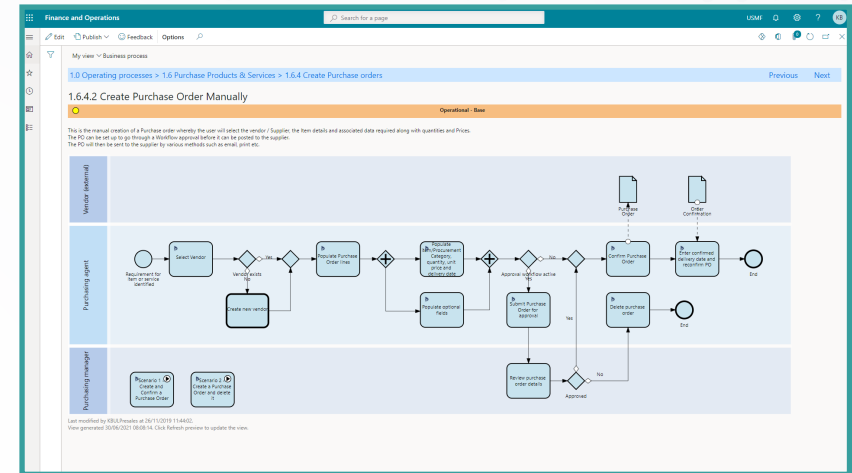
- **Ideal Participants for the process between Day 1 and Day 2:** Customer's lead solution architects and LoB (this process will not include Columbus experts)
- By the end of this process, you should be able to:
 - Define the scope and shortlist of processes that are relevant for your organization using the process library and ensuring it matches the value chain
 - Capture high-level requirements and align them with specific processes
 - Map your business functions with the updated value chain from the library and nominate the respective functional leads/owners to attend training 2



Training Day 2:

Day 2 of training will involve learning and testing how Dynamics 365 F&O will help you improve the chosen processes. It will also include additional Rapid Value training.

- **Ideal Participants for the process between Day 1 and Day 2:** Customer's lead solution architects, Project managers, Heads of LoB and employees working with relevant areas
- By the end of Day 2:
 - Heads of LoB will clarify the scope and adjust the structure of the processes to the updated value chain. They will be able to create process requirements, identify and document gaps related to customization and integration.
 - Process owners / employees will understand which processes are relevant to them, learn how to use the task guides, and how Dynamics 365 works
 - The organization as a whole structure will be ready to start an ERP implementation
