Aadhaar masking regulations are managed by UIDAI which is overseen by RBI, IRDAI, TRAI, and SEBI. In May 2019, RBI modified the master directive for KYC guidelines for regulated entities. As per the guidelines, all regulated entities, regardless of industry type or business size, must mask the first eight digits of a customer's Aadhaar number & QR code before storage. RBI has also permitted entities to utilize AI and automation technology to mask Aadhaar in minimal time.

- Aadhaar and its regulations are governed by UIDAI and followed by numerous regulators such as RBI, IRDAI, TRAI and SEBI. The regulations mandate that every business collecting Aadhaar cards mask the first eight digits of the Aadhaar number once the KYC is completed. You can refer to the following regulations with regard to Aadhaar masking.

WHY?

In recent years, Aadhaar has become one of India's most widely used identification documents. Issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI), Aadhaar contains biometric and demographic information of individuals and is used for various purposes, including availing of government subsidies, opening bank accounts, filing taxes, and more. However, with the increased usage of Aadhaar, concerns have arisen regarding the protection of individuals' personal information and the potential for identity theft or data breaches. In response to these concerns, the government of India has issued guidelines on Aadhaar masking, emphasizing the importance of safeguarding individuals' privacy.



When sharing or using Aadhaar, individuals should mask or cover the first eight digits of the Aadhaar number, leaving only the last four digits visible. This helps in preventing the misuse of Aadhaar numbers and protects individuals from identity theft.


