



Registration

To use the platform, a user must sign-up at <https://app.feenix.ai/signup>, where they will need to provide their name, email, and create a password.



Login


After approval, the user will be notified via email and at that point the user can login at <https://app.feenix.ai/login> using the email and password created during the sign-up stage.

Creating Organizations


After logging in, the user will be prompted to create an organization, which typically maps to a company or business unit. This organization will be the parent entity that all marketplace seller accounts, and team members will be under. With seller accounts in an organization, administrators can easily allocate resources, accounts, and apply governance policies to user accounts. A user can create multiple organizations if they prefer to isolate the different seller accounts, but one organization is sufficient.

Adding Marketplace Seller Account

Once an organization has been created, the user can proceed to add one or more of their marketplace seller accounts. Each account required the completion of several sections **1/ "General"** where the user creates a name for the account and selects corresponding CSP **2/ "Configuration/Settings"** where the user can grant access, and **3/ "Repository"** where the user can add administrative account information for easy reference.
