PACT

The Positive Achievement Change Tool is a leading juvenile risk and needs assessment, and is comprised of two assessments: the PACT Pre-screen (PACT Pre) and the PACT Full-Screen (PACT Full) instruments. The PACT Pre is a short screener designed to give practitioner and screening personnel a simple, quick evaluation of a youth's risk level based on criminal and social history background. The PACT Full is a more comprehensive instrument providing insight into the behavioral needs of youth.

R-PACT

The Residential Positive Achievement Change Tool (R-PACT) is an assessment instrument modified from the Positive Achievement Change Tool (PACT.) It was created specifically for residential programs and can be used as an independent instrument or can be pre-populated with responses from the PACT. Its purpose is to identify the youth's highest scoring criminogenic needs, guide the development of intervention strategies and assist with determining a youth's progress in residential programs.

CSE-IT

The Commercial Sexual Exploitation - Identification Tool (CSE-IT) is a validated tool used to aid in the early identification of sexual trafficking and exploitation of youth.

DRAI

Based on work from the Annie E. Casey Foundation, the Detention Risk Assessment Instrument is a juvenile assessment tool designed to provide release/detain decision guidance to corrections and institution staff, and specifically seeks to reduce unnecessary or inappropriate secure confinement of children.

JSORATT-II

The JSORATT-II is a 12-item static risk assessment designed to give risk estimates for the sexual reoffending of male youth that have been adjudicated for sexual offense. It has been validated in Utah and Iowa, and is used in many agencies nationally.

PREA

An automated assessment used to fulfill the requirements of PREA Standard 115.341 that requires facilities to obtain and use information about each resident's personal history and behavior to reduce the risk of sexual abuse by or upon a resident.
