



Proven solution design

- Framework to prioritize automation candidates
- Standardized control tests (e.g., data models, testing logic, scripts, reporting, logging)
- Functional tools (e.g., data connectivity, data preparation / workflows, logging, notifications)
- Repeatability of code across controls



Continuous monitoring

- Automated, full population testing (e.g., from quarterly to continuous)
- Flexibility in triggers for alerts (i.e.,, manual, scheduled or event-based execution of control test)
- Control test exception (pass/fail) reporting and automated notifications
- Front-end collaboration tools (e.g., file sharing, task assignments)

External audit reliance & reduced fees

- Technical testing and parallel testing to support reliance and ensure completeness and accuracy

- Reduced test cycle times (e.g., quarterly to weekly)
- Increased assurance coverage (i.e., sampling to full population coverage)
- Centralized presentation of results with historical performance trends
