The need for Records Management

Today, organizations rely on teamwork with employees working on twice as many teams as they did just five years ago, and information workers spending **50% more time collaborating** with co-workers, outside contractors, suppliers and customers. To succeed, you need collaboration and communication tools that empower your workforce to be more agile, efficient, secure so they can stay connected.

Whilst organisations are keeping connected through Microsoft 365 more data is being stored in cloud services than before with 88% of organisations losing confidence in their ability to detect and prevent loss of sensitive data, with around >80% of corporate data being classified as "dark" i.e. not classified. Protecting sensitive data throughout its lifecycle is a #1 focus for public sector and commercially sensitive organisations.
