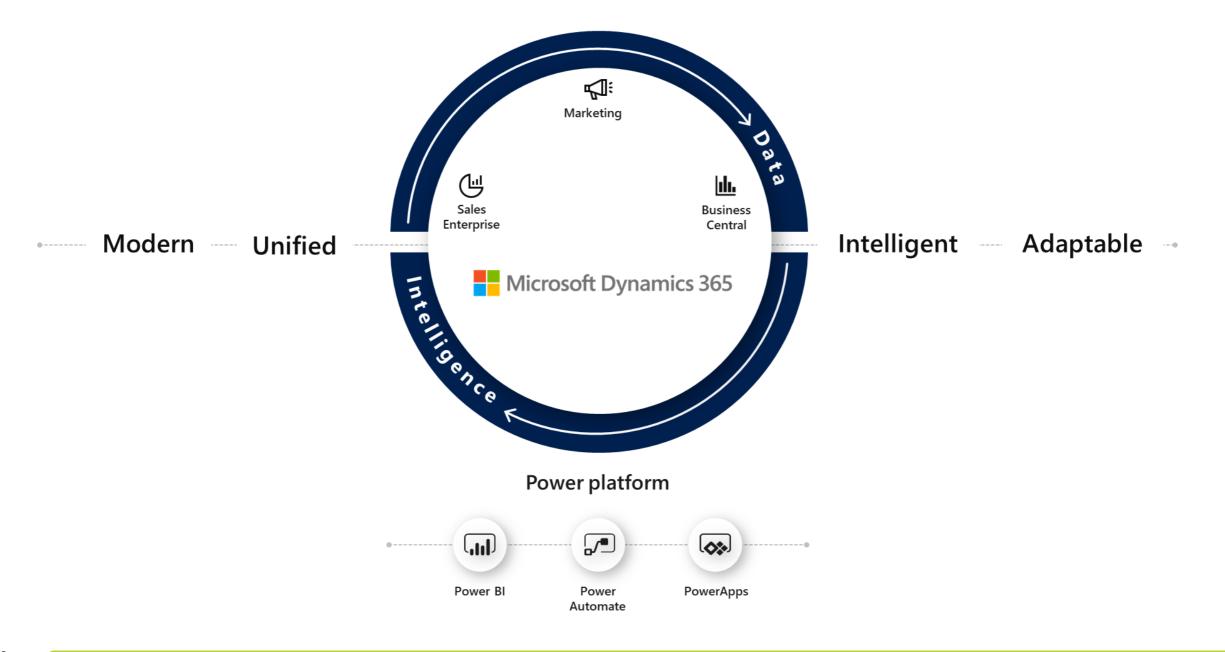

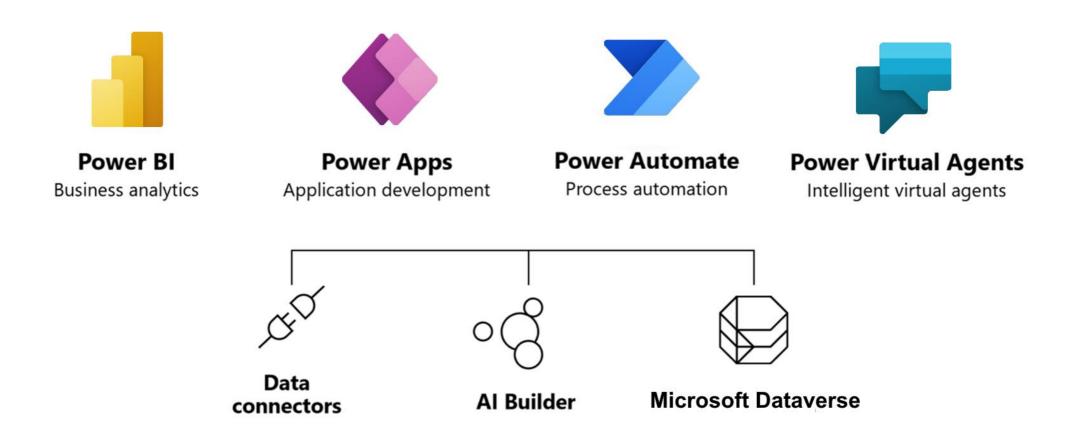

The low-code platform that spans Office 365, Azure, Dynamics 365, and standalone applications





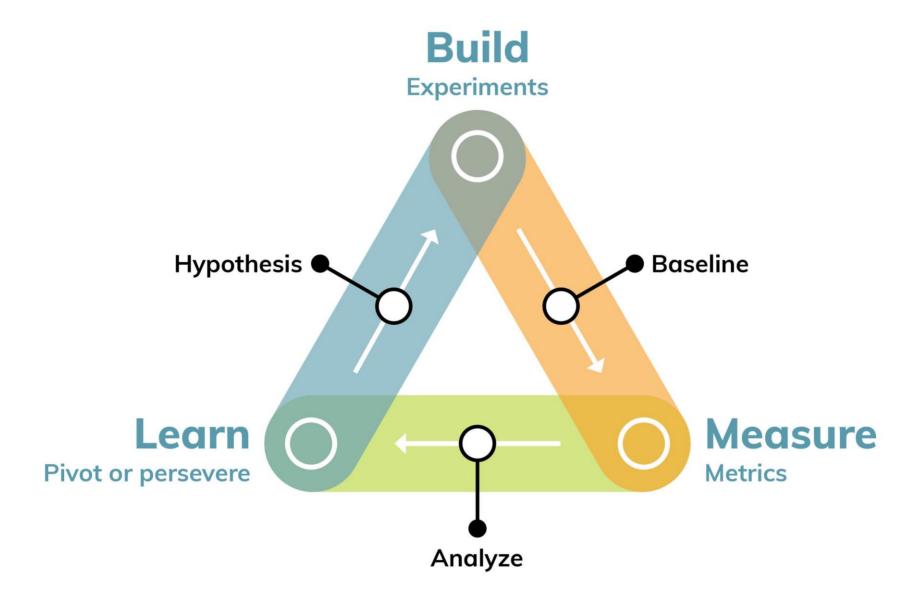

- Design no code, low-code portals for external users using <u>Power Apps portals</u>.

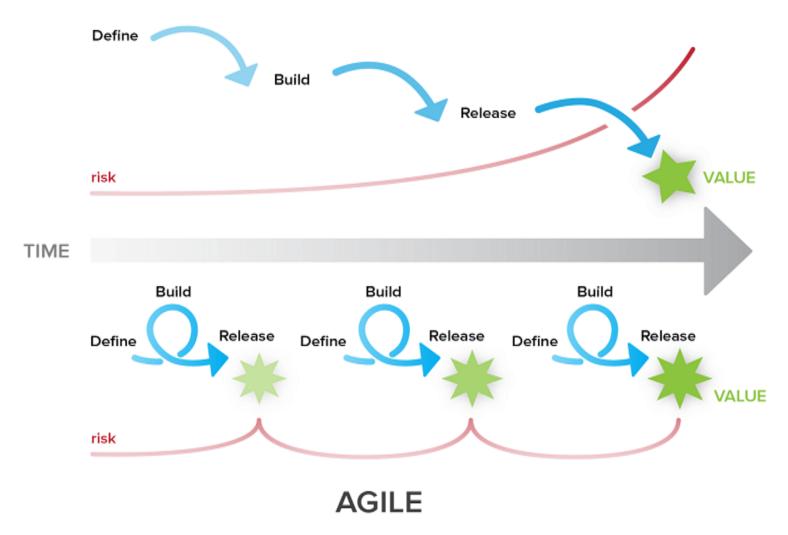


Agile

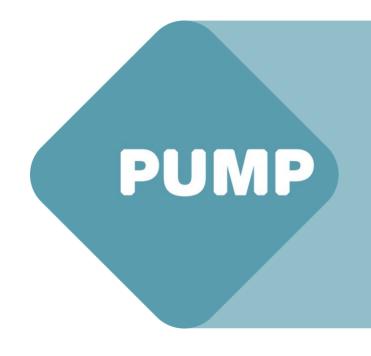
Intelligent

- Pump connects with Microsoft's next-generation, multi-channel applications such as <u>Dynamics 365 Sales</u> Enterprise, focused on relationship building at scale and lead nurturing – with predictive, Al-driven <u>Sales Insights</u> that are being continuously improved.

Licensing Basics

Pump Annual Subscription: £100 per user per month

- This subscription includes Pump as a model-driven Power App embedded within Microsoft Dynamics 365 Sales Enterprise.
- Commitment is to the annual subscription price and use rights, but license numbers can be varied down to single license at any time.
- Textkernel Extract! CV Parsing service is included with fair usage of 1000 documents per user per year pooled over all users.
- Technical and User Support for Pump, and any licensed Microsoft Business Application, is provided through to designated users through private Microsoft Teams
 channels and includes a two weekly Sprint Review and access to a Knowledgebase. Support includes guidance on customisations. Support Policy available on
 request.
- See your entitled **Power Platform use rights (Power Apps + Power Automate)** with Dynamics 365 Sales Enterprise on <u>page 6 of the Power Apps and Power Automate Licensing Guide.</u>
- See your **Dynamics 365 Sales Enterprise application use rights** on page 28-29 of the Dynamics 365 Licensing guide.
- Common Data Service Database storage includes 10 GB by default, and an additional 250 MB per user. Additional database capacity can be purchased at £30.20 per 1 GB. There is also Common Data Service Log and File Storage. Please see the Dynamics 365 Licensing Guide, page 39-41 for more information.
- Pump / Dynamics 365 utilises Sharepoint for storing non-CV documents. Storage costs are covered under your existing Microsoft 365 licensing.
- Please see the **Microsoft Power Platform API Request limits** for Dynamics 365 Sales Enterprise <u>here</u>. Currently they are at 20,000 per user per 24 hours. We do not envision Pump going over this limit.
- Pump can be extended with <u>Dynamics 365 Marketing</u>, <u>Dynamics 365 Business Central</u>, <u>Power Apps Portals</u>, <u>Power Bl Pro</u>, <u>Power Virtual Agents</u>. Use rights can be found within the guides referenced above and pricing can be found within the hyper links referenced.
