



D365 Checklists Test Drive


The ultimate to-do lists & checklists for Microsoft Dynamics 365



Enhance the usefulness of Dynamics 365 records with multi-function **D365 Checklists**. Make life simple again with this easy add-on.








What are **Checklists** and how do they work?

- Checklists are a collection of to-do items or steps in a process
- Users can manage checklist items on the fly, or use templated lists

Some features of the **Checklists** add-on:


- Add **Checklists** to Dynamics 365 records (System or Custom entities)
- **Checklists** behave like normal Dynamics 365 form elements. Edits make the form "dirty" immediately, using Save, Save & Close or Mark Complete commits changes.
- Status values available for items: (click to cycle through)
 - **Blank** (not started) **☑ Tick** (completed) **② Cross** (cancelled) **Partial** (in progress)
- Ledit existing items or Reset already completed items to start fresh
- **\$ Sort** items with a simple drag-n-drop
- Delete existing items
- The User's name and date/time is recorded when an item is modified
- List progress is displayed, and when completed are visually represented





You can setup pre-configured **Checklist Templates** that users can start with on demand. This is particularly helpful for repetitive processes.

- Create a new Checklist Template called "My Repeating List"
- Add your checklist items, **Edit**, **Resort** or **Delete** as required
- **Lock** items that you want to be enforced/mandatory for end-users (*This means users can tick/cross them, but not edit or delete them*)
- When done just Save & Close
- On any Checklist now users can click **Use Template**
- Select the "My Repeating List" template
- The templated items are merged into their Checklist!



You can also deliver **Checklist Templates** in Dynamics 365 **Workflows**. This can help if you wish to automate record creation/delivery along with a pre-configured checklist.


- Create a new Workflow to create a Task record
- Add the **Add Checklist Template** custom step
- Edit the custom step and define the "My Repeating List" template
- Save & Publish the Workflow
- When executed a new Task is created with your **Checklist Template** already inside!


- Sign-in with your Microsoft credentials

- You can jump straight in and click the "Try A Checklist!" button




This will create a new Task for you where we have placed the Checklist control
