1. INTRODUCTION

Purpose of this Guide

There are some OOTB email templates that occupies a lot of MS CRM memory space and third party image hosting is required, so to reduce the CRM memory space and avoid the third-party image hosting, pragma email designer has created an azure blob storage.

What is Azure Blob Storage?


Azure Storage is a Microsoft-managed cloud service that provides storage that is highly available, secure, durable, scalable, and redundant. Azure blob storage is used to for storing the image bytes and thereafter a uniform resource locator of the intended email is passed to it.



2. CREATION OF AN EMAIL TEMPLATE


Steps to follow:

- 1.) Click on Settings sitemap and click on the pragma email designer option
- 2.) Click on the '+' button to create a new template
- 3.) Select the required entity from the dropdown list and click on ok button
- 4.) Provide the title, description and subject content and save the template






This is how the UI looks. Here all the out of box email templates are fetched.











3. UPDATION OF AN EMAIL TEMPLATE


Steps to follow:

- 1.) Click on the edit icon as highlighted below of the created template to make amendments.
- 2.) Provide the updated content/add an image and click on 'save and close' button
- 3.) Click on the Ok button of the popup 'Template saved'






The body part of the email template is updated and an image can be added to the template if required. Click on the insert image icon as highlighted below.




User can even upload an image from the +UPLOAD button available






Select the image and insert the image into the email template




Click on save and close button

- Blob(Cloud) platform is available for all time
- Easy to configure Azure Connection in Azure Configuration Entity
 - a. Storage Key
 - b. Storage Account
 - c. Container Name
 - d. Blob Path
- Easy to configure Azure Connection in Azure Configuration Entity
- Easy to check the attachment in the Azure Cloud by clicking on the view attachment button on an entity.
- This gives a good look and feel to the user interface.
