Classes

- 😊 On your **Home** page you will see a JogNog class displayed
- 😊 If you created the class you can:
 - ✓ Edit the class name and description (click on the **pencil**)
 - ✓ Delete the class (click on the **pencil**)

Co-teachers


- 🧐 You can allow other teachers to access a class that you own
- 🧐 Click on **Home**
- 🧐 Click on **“Choose class”**
- 🧐 If you are the owner of the class you will see **Co-teachers**
- 🧐 Click on **Co-teachers**
- 🧐 Add the co-teacher’s **‘user name’**.
- 🧐 The co-teacher can find their user name by clicking on the link at the top right corner of their JogNog Home page.
- 🧐 Sometimes the user name may be a long string of characters. Copy and paste it into the Co-teachers entry box.

Points and Coins

🧐 Points

- ✓ A student earns a point the first time they answer a question correctly.
- ✓ They do not earn further coins for re-answering the same question.
- ✓ Points are denoted by a plus sign '+'
- ✓ Points are displayed on the class leaderboards.

Report: First score / last score

Research: Improved test scores

🧐 Experimental Question



- ✓ Will using JogNog increase the average state test scores for a school?

🧐 Experimental Design

- ✓ Collect diverse sample of Massachusetts schools
- ✓ Compare state test scores before and after JogNog is used

🧐 Experimental Results

- ✓ Schools using JogNog saw a 5.2% rise in proficiency in state tests scores. These schools had seen only a 0.8% increase from the best previous intervention.



Research: Practice raised scores

🧐 Experimental Question

- ✓ Will more recall practice through JogNog result in even higher state test scores?

🧐 Experimental Design

- ✓ Collect diverse sample of Massachusetts schools
- ✓ Compare the amount of student effort spent in different subject areas with test score improvement in those subject areas

🧐 Experimental Results

- ✓ A strong positive correlation between effort spent practicing with JogNog and test outcome ($p=0.0003$)
- ✓ The more that students used JogNog, the more the test scores improved




Figure 4: Each point on the graph represents a school that entered the JSC. Some schools participated fully and completed the challenge but even the schools that did not complete the challenge showed improvement from partial completion. Note that viewing and answering a larger number of questions in the JSC is strongly correlated with a positive change in MCAS performance vs. the state average ($p = 0.0003$, single-tailed paired T-test).

Research: Longitudinal studies

🧐 Experimental Question

- ✓ Are JogNog results repeatable over many years?

🧐 Experimental Design

- ✓ Conduct research over 6 years
- ✓ Combine results using a sliding time window and looking at changes in test scores between years for the three years prior to the intervention

🧐 Experimental Results

- ✓ More than 5% increase in passing rate for state test when JogNog was used
- ✓ Average change in previous years without JogNog was from 1.5% to -2%
