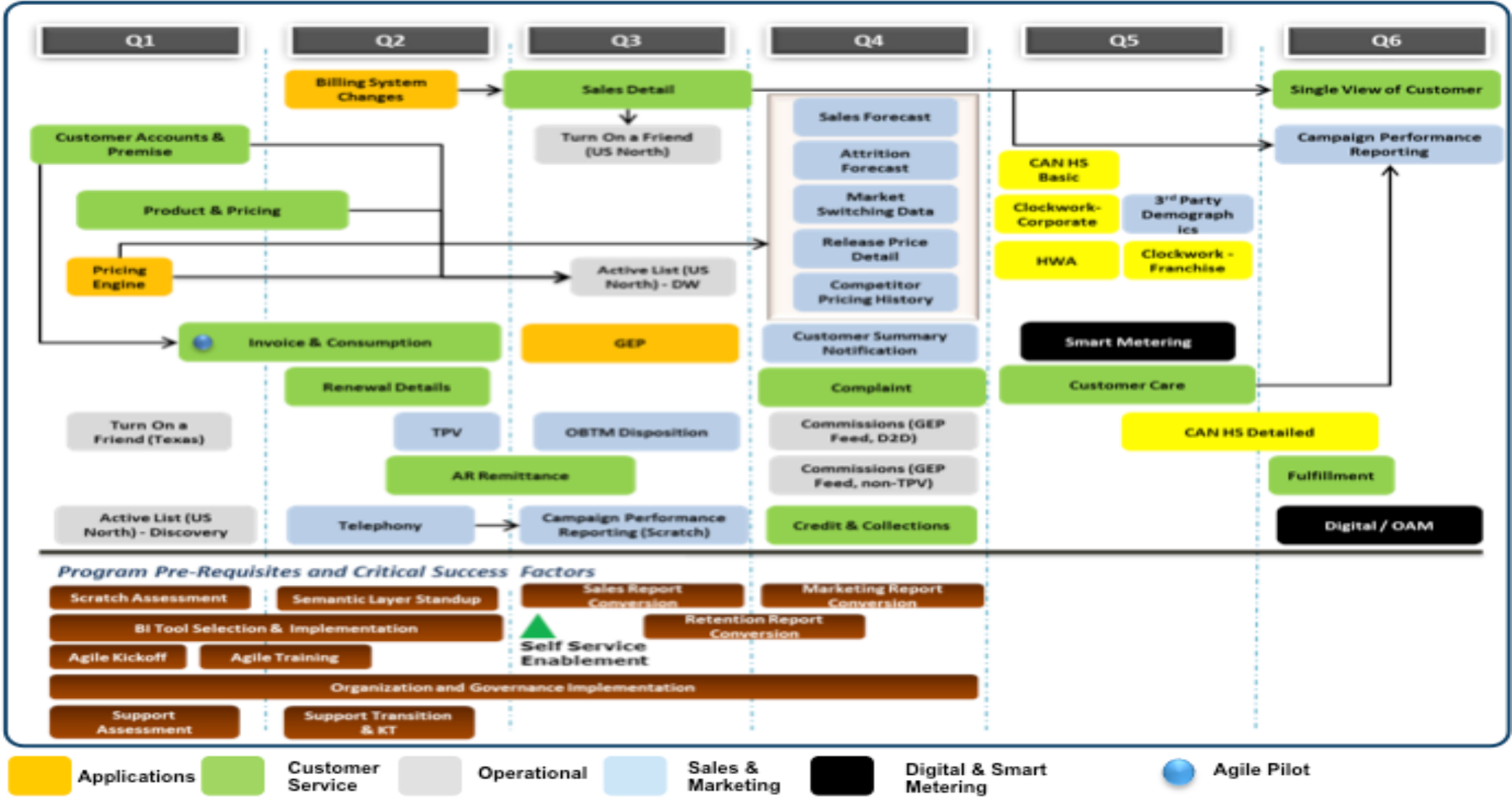

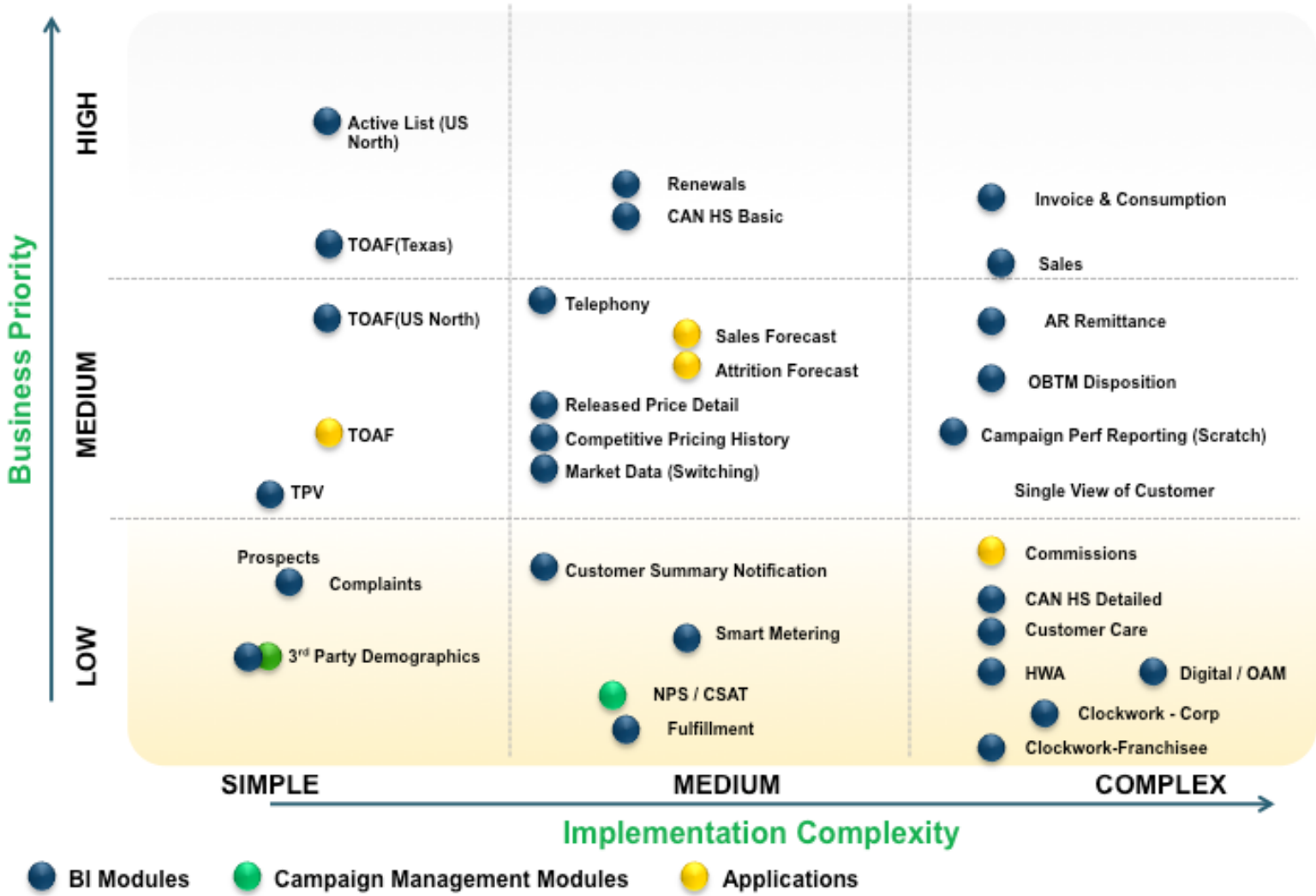
# Sample Charts from Workshop Analysis of the Enterprise



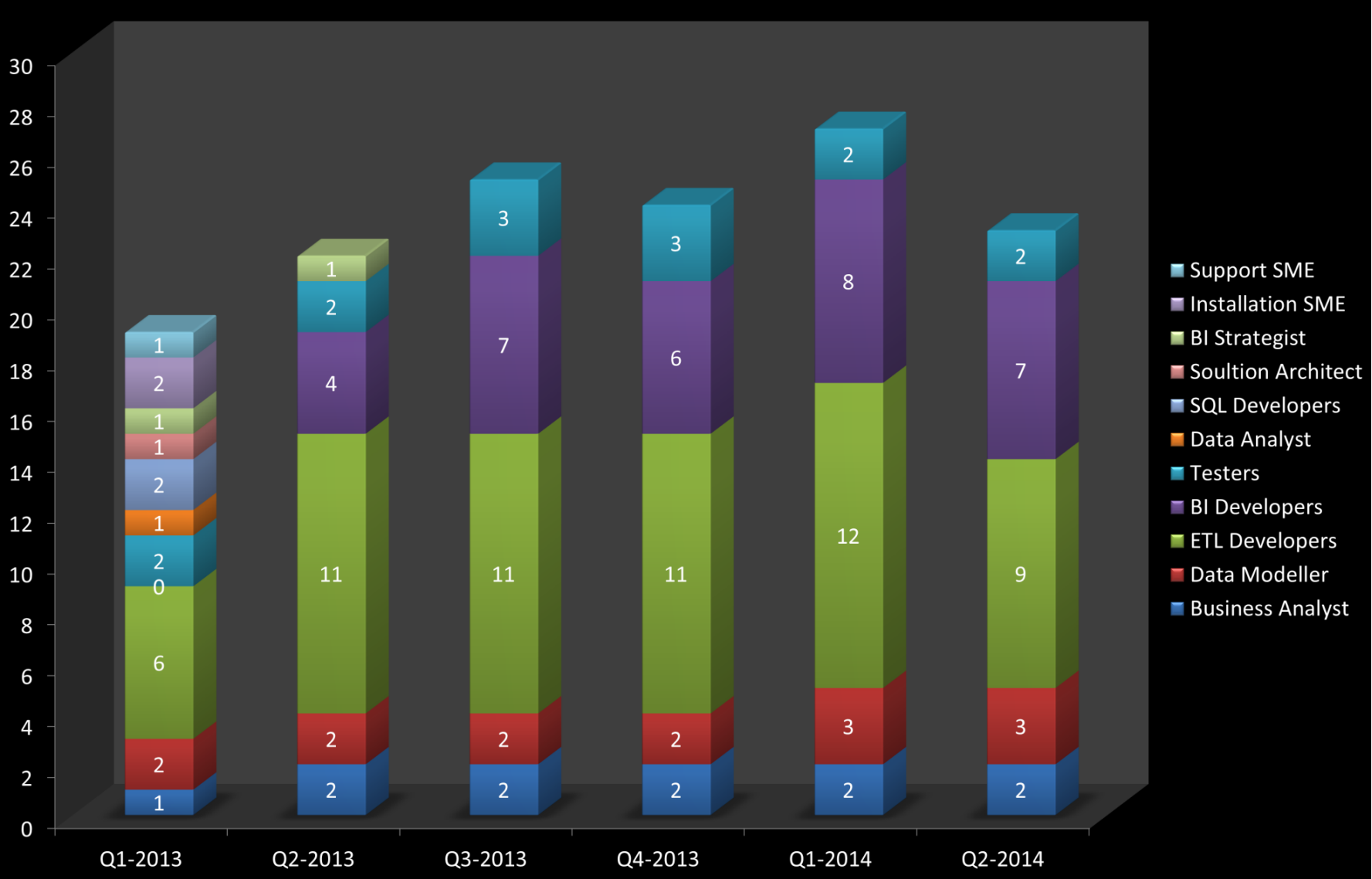
# Innovation Workshop Output - Roadmap Timeline with Dependencies (Sample)



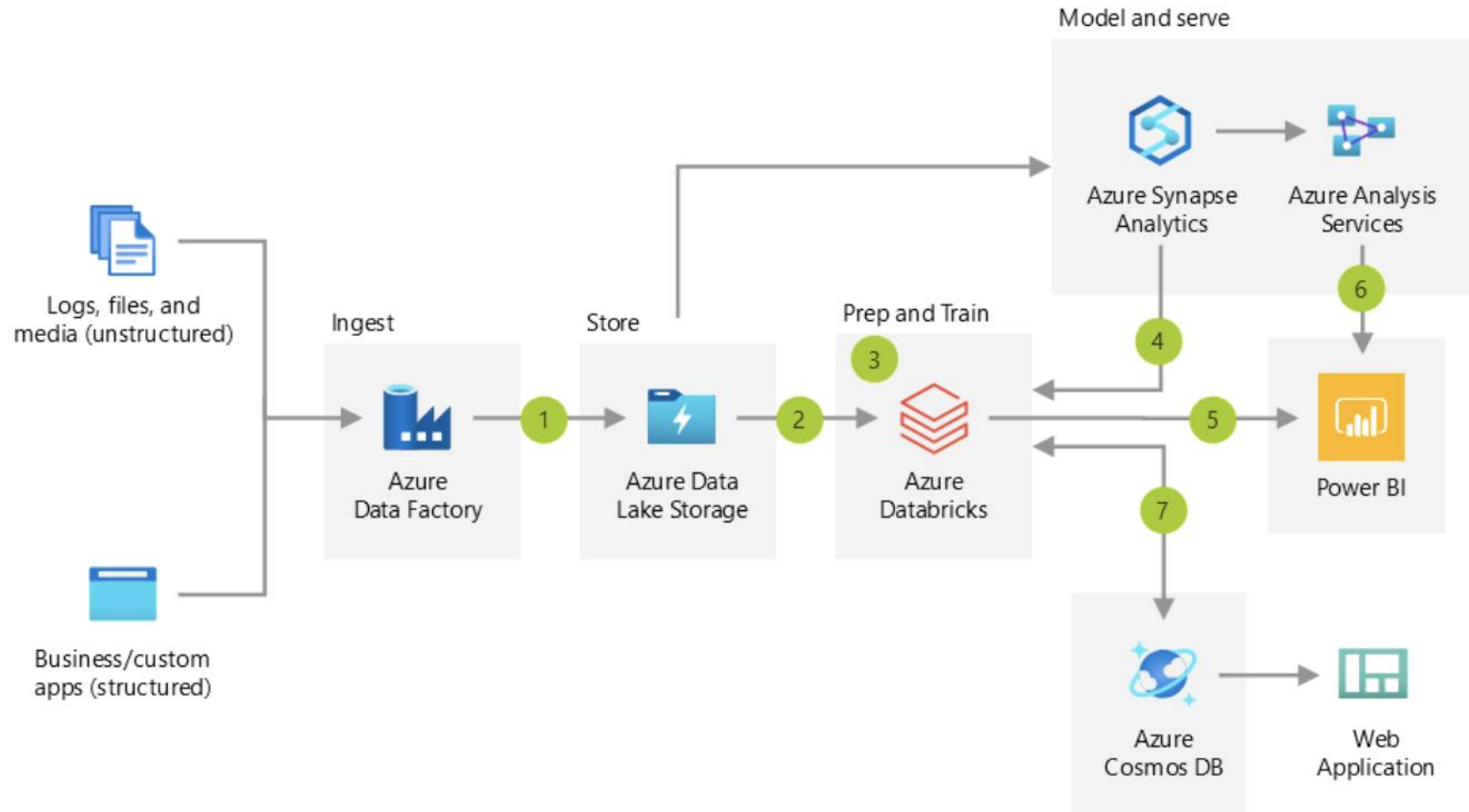
# Discovery Workshop Output - Prioritization Matrix (Sample)
