Office 365 Groups is one of the foundational pieces of the Office 365 collaboration toolkit that ties together SharePoint, Exchange, Teams, Planner, PowerBI, etc. A group is created with a shared inbox for conversations, a shared calendar, a place to take notes with OneNote, Planner to manage tasks, and the option to connect to the hub for teamwork in Microsoft Teams.
