





Pilot Deployment

Overview:

The Windows Virtual Desktop (WVD) pilot gives you the ability to test the delivery of desktops and applications from Azure. As part of the engagement, Foundation IT will:

- 1. Setup your Azure tenant (if required)
- 2. Setup your WVD tenant and management console
- 3. Configure Azure Active Directory Connect and Hybrid Domain Join for devices
- 4. Create baseline group policies for WVD desktops
- 5. Configure the FSLogix user profile management tool





- 6. Build a Windows 10 Multi-User desktop pool, including Office 365
- 7. Handover service for user testing

Outcomes:

As part of the trial, we will deliver:

- A Windows Virtual Desktop pool with an agreed user capacity for the pilot
- Baseline configuration to ensure correct functionality
- Detailed service overview and handover to internal resources (if required)

Benefits:

This trial will allow your organisation to quickly and easily asses the functionality and benefits of the Windows Virtual Desktop platform with preagreed activities and deliverables. Foundation IT will also provide a comprehensive overview of the anticipated service and licencing costs for the pilot and for any future expansion of the platform.

- Remove the costs associated with supporting or upgrading remote device issues
- Manage all desktops, applications and updates centrally
