Prerequisites are recommendations, and while not required, they are *highly* advised to ensure a successful learning experience:

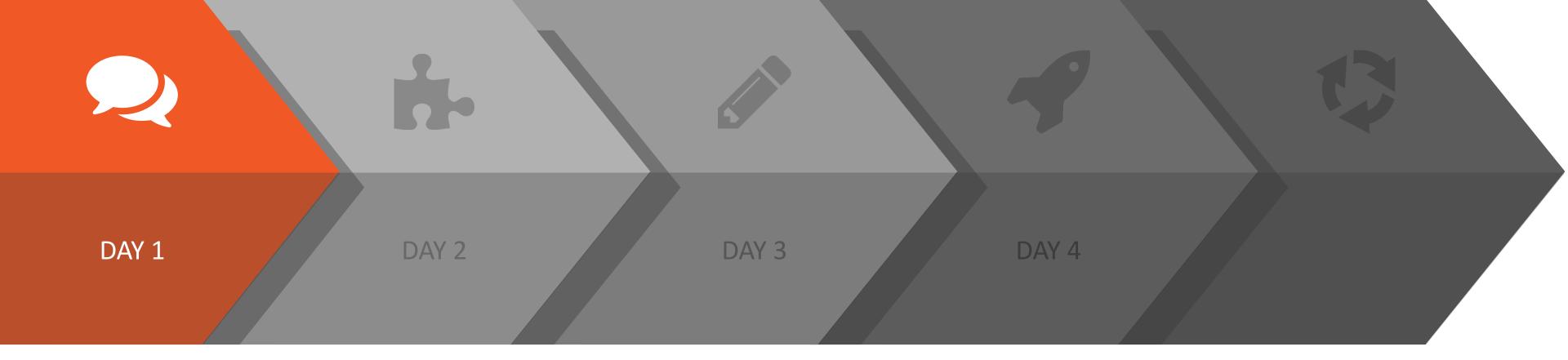

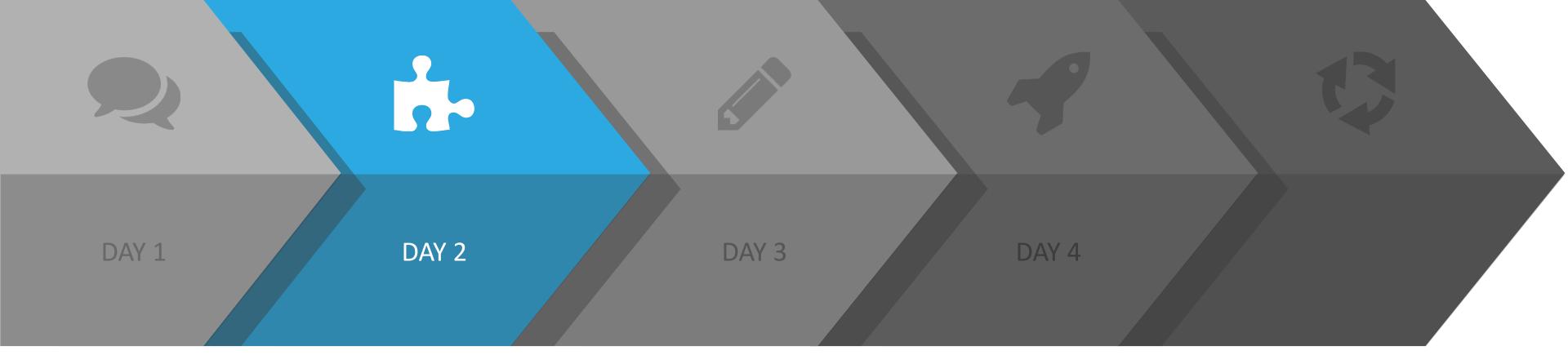

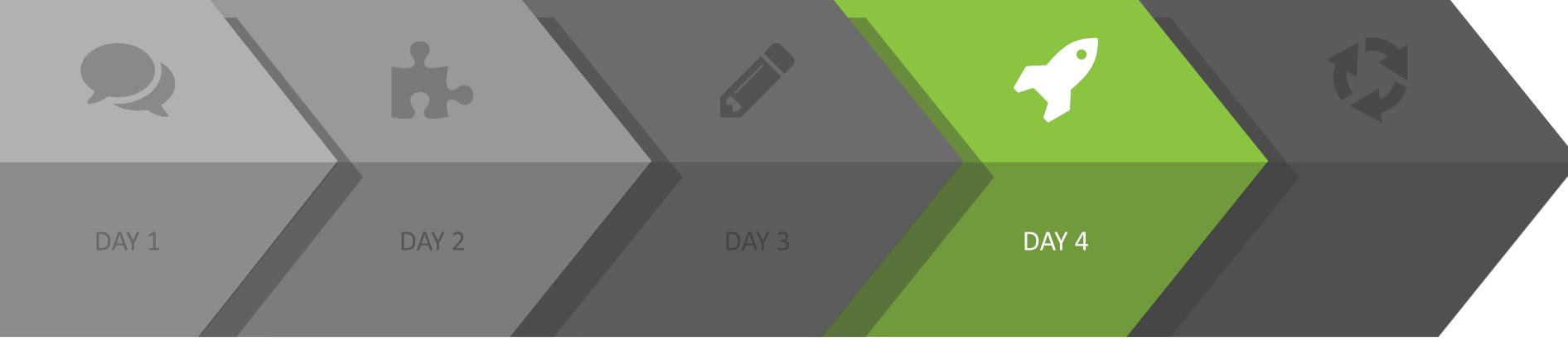
