

Financial Stability

First year retention rates can have a significant

impact on a university's annual revenue. Based on a review of 255 institutions between years 2014-2018, the following stats represent the cost of lost students.



	National Universities	Regional Universities	Regional Colleges	Liberal Arts Colleges
Average Cost of Attendance	\$52k	\$43K	\$40K	\$56K
Average Freshman Retention Rate	80%	73%	83%	80%
Revenue Lost by First-Year Students Not Returning	\$10m	\$7m	\$5.1m	\$3.2m

Federal financial aid regulations require institutions to be able to document attendance in each class for which a student has received Title IV aid. If a student has a


Why Institutions Should Care About
